



Drop and Withdrawal Guide

Adjusting your schedule for a term is an important decision to make. It may impact your progress to complete your degree in a timely manner. Timely completion allows you to begin your career much sooner, resulting in financial gains for you. It may also impact your financial aid and repayment of loans.

Census, drop and withdrawal dates for each session are published on the Academic Calendar <https://registrar.unt.edu/registration-guides-by-semester>

To determine which session your course is in, search the schedule of classes and locate your course or refer to the Start and End Dates listed for the course on My Classes within the myUNT portal.

After census, courses will appear on the official transcript with a grade of W.	Before census, tuition & financial aid may be adjusted. After census, there is no tuition adjustment.	Enrolled	Adjust schedule through myUNT
Session Withdrawal	Student drops all courses in an academic session, even if they are enrolled in another session.	First day of session or term but before the withdrawal deadline for the session or term	Before census, courses will not appear on the transcript. After census, courses will appear on the official transcript with a grade of W.	Students may be eligible for a tuition adjustment based on when the student completes the withdrawal for that session (TEC §54.006.) Financial aid may be adjusted.	Enrolled	Adjust schedule through myUNT
Withdrawal from the University	Student drops all courses for the entire term. There is no enrollment in any session.	First day of session or term but before the withdrawal deadline for the session or term	Before census, courses will not appear on the transcript. After census, courses will appear on the official transcript with a grade of W.	Students may be eligible for a tuition adjustment based on when the student completes the withdrawal for that session (TEC §54.006.) Financial aid may be adjusted.	Not enrolled	Contact the Dean of Students Office.
