Course Topic: INTL HUMANITARIAN INTERVENTION

INTERNATIONAL HUMANITARIAN INTERVENTION: AID PROTECTION

THIS COURSE WILL EXAMINE MODERN DAY INTERNATIONAL RESPONSES TO THE EMERGENCY NEEDS OF PEOPLE DAMAGED BY BOTH MAJOR NATURAL DISASTERS AND BY THE MULTITUDE OF INTER AND INTRA STATE CONFLICTS THAT HAVE ARISEN IN MUCH OF THE WORLD SINCE THE END OF THE COLD WAR. STUDENTS WILL LEARN THE DIFFERENT KINDS OF FOREIGN ASSISTANCE, THE FORMS SUCH ASSISTANCE TAKE, AND THE POTENTIAL FOR "RESCUERS" CAUSING DAMAGE AS WELL AS SAVING LIVES. CONSIDERABLE ATTENTION WILL BE DEVOTED TO THE UNITED STATES' ROLE AND RECORD IN DEALING WITH HUMANITARIAN CRISES AROUND THE WORLD. GIVEN THE INCREASING ROLE OF NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL MILITARY FORCES IN HUMANITARIAN RESPONSES, THE COURSE WILL EXAMINE THE ARGUMENTS FOR AND AGAINST SUCH INTERVENTIONS.

GLOBAL DEVELOPMENT: ISSUES & CHALLENGES

THIS CAPSTONE SEMINAR IS REQUIRED FOR STUDENTS WHOSE CONCENTRATION IS INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT. IT IS DESIGNED PRIMARILY FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDIES MAJORS IN THEIR SENIOR YEAR. THE SEMINAR EXPLORES THE COMPETING PERSPECTIVES THAT ADDRESS THE SOCIAL, ECONOMIC, AND POLITICAL ASPECTS OF DEVELOPMENT. THE COURSE ALSO SURVEYS SOME OF THE CHALLENGES FACING BOTH HIGH-INCOME AND LOWER-INCOME COUNTRIES, SUCH AS GLOBALIZATION, MIGRATION, THE ROLE OF CULTURE IN DEVELOPMENT, FOREIGN AID AND GENDER ISSUES.
