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The College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences expects students to have completed the Texas State recommended high school program and be ready to enroll in Language 2040 (TCCNS: Language 2311). If you are not prepared for this level, the necessary prerequisites will either replace electives or increase the hours required for this degree.

Courses Recommended for Transfer

The UNT Core requirements are shown with Texas Common Course Numbering System values only when UNT offers equivalent courses. There may be other courses in transfer that apply toward the specific degree requirement, but those listed are known to apply.

GERM 3040 and 3050, options for the major, will apply to both the UNT Core Language, Philosophy and Culture, and German Major requirements.

UNT Core: Social & Behavioral Sciences

UNT Core: Component Area Option

Complete two courses from Component Area Option A OR one course from Component Area Option A AND one course from Component Area Option B.

GERM 3040 and 3050, options for the major, will apply to both the UNT Core Component Area Option, and German Major requirements.

College of Liberal Arts & Social Sciences Core: Distribution Requirement

Students pursuing the Bachelor of Arts degree must complete two courses (3 hours each) of advanced work at UNT in:

- Cultural Diversity & Global Issues: Focused on cultural diversity in regional, national or international contexts, depending on the nature of the course. 3 hours from an approved Study Abroad program can substitute for this requirement.
- Communication & Digital Skills: Focused on developing written, oral or visual communication skills using discipline-specific digital technologies.

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Major courses can be used to satisfy both the CLASS Distribution requirement and your major requirements, see your academic advisor for assistance in making the best choice of CLASS

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B. A. German: Major Requirements

A minimum of 39 hours of foreign language, including: GERM 1311 or 1411 or 1511, GERM 1312 or 1412 or 1512, GERM 2311 and GERM 2312, plus 27 semester hours of advanced work, including 9 hours in 4000-level courses or above. Placement or credit by examination may be used to satisfy the courses listed above.

Courses listed above are TCCNS options and do not include all courses required for the UNT B.A. German major.

B. A. German: Other Course Requirements

Students majoring in German should consider taking history and geography courses that deal specifically with their language study:

- a minimum grade of C is required for a course to count toward the major;
- minimum GPA of 2.75 in German course work is required for graduation.

Teacher Certification Option

The College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences encourages students to explore teaching at the secondary level as a career option. A higher GPA may be required for the certification option. For more information contact your advisor.

Special Notes

Hours Required and General/College Requirements: A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Arts degree as specified in the <u>General University Requirements</u> section of the UNT catalog and the College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences requirements

UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum: UNT complies with the <u>mandates of the 1997 Texas Legislature</u> regarding requirements for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

Choice of Catalog: Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.
