## **Courses Recommended for Transfer**

The UNT Core requirements, with the exception of American History and the College & Major requirements, are shown with Texas Common Course Numbering System values only when UNT offers equivalent courses. There may be other courses in transfer that apply toward the specific degree requirement, but those listed are known to apply.

#### **UNT Core: Communication**

ENGL 1301; and ENGL 1302 or 2311

A grade of  $\mbox{{\sc C'}}$  or better is required on courses applied toward this requirement.

#### **UNT Core: Component Area Option Category I**

This requirement will be met by fulfilling the Health Promotion program requirements (see "Program Requirements" below).

#### **UNT Core: Mathematics**

One course chosen from: MATH 1316, 1324, 1325 or 1425, 1332, 1342 or 1442 or 2342 or 2442, 1350, 2312 or 2412, 2313 or 2413 or 2513

## **UNT Core: Component Area Option Category II**

One additional course from any other UNT Core requirement. This requirement will be met by fulfilling the Health Promotion program requirements.

## **UNT Core: Life & Physical Sciences**

This requirement will be met by fulfilling the Health Promotion program requirements (see "Program Requirements" next column).

## UNT Core: American History

Two courses chosen from: HIST 1301, 1302, 2301

#### **Health Promotion: Program Requirements**

- BIOL 2401 (fulfills both Life & Physical Sciences core and program requirements)
- BIOL 2402 (fulfills both Life & Physical Sciences core and program requirements)
- ENGL 2332 (fulfills both Language, Philosophy and Culture core and program requirements)
- BIOL/HECO 1322 (fulfills both CAO Category I core and program requirements)
- KINE 1304 or PHED 1304
- PHED 1306 (substitutes for HLTH 3300, but will not count toward advanced hours requirement)
- PHED/KINE 1338 (substitutes for PHED 1000)
- PHED 1346 (substitutes for HLTH 3120, but will not count toward advanced hours requirement)
- SPCH 1315 or 1318 (SPCH 1318 is recommended for the Community Health track and fulfills both program and Communication Studies minor requirements)
- TECA 1318 (required for the Community Health track only)

## **UNT Core: Creative Arts**

One course chosen from: ARTS 1301 or 1304; DRAM 1310; MUSI 1306; SPCH 2341

## UNT Core: Language, Philosophy and Culture

This requirement will be met by fulfilling the Health Promotion program requirements (see "Program Requirements" next column).

Courses listed above are TCCNS options and do not include all courses required for the UNT Health Promotion major.

## **UNT Core: Social & Behavioral Sciences**

One course chosen from: ANTH 2346 or 2351; COMM 1307; CRIJ 1301; ECON 2301 or 2302; GEOG 1303; PSYC 2301; SOCI 1301; SOCW 2361; SPCH 1318; TECA 1354

AGER 4800 taken at UNT is recommended to fulfill both Social & Behavioral Sciences core and Health Promotion program requirements.

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#### **Special Notes**

## Hours Required and General/College Requirements:

- A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Science degree as specified in the <u>general</u> <u>university requirements</u> section of the UNT catalog and the College of Education requirements.
- A minimum grade of C is required in each course in the major; a minimum GPA of 2.75 in the major, a minimum UNT GPA of 2.0, and a minimum overall GPA of 2.0 is required for graduation. (Overall GPA includes all course work transferred plus that taken at UNT.)

**UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum:** UNT complies with the <u>mandates of the 1997 Texas Legislature</u> regarding requirements for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

**Choice of Catalog:** Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college
