Undergraduate Degree Program Options

B.S. Education, Early Childhood—6th Grade (EC-6) Teacher Certification:

- EC-6 Core Subjects with EC-12 Special Education
- EC-6 Core Subjects with Bilingual Supplemental
- EC-6 Core Subjects with ESL Supplemental

Courses Recommended for Transfer

The UNT Core requirements are shown with Texas Common Course Numbering System values only when UNT offers equivalent courses. There may be other courses in transfer that apply toward the specific degree requirement, but those listed are known to apply.

Education, EC-6 Certification:

- **All grades for the courses taken for these programs must be a C or higher. This includes core courses, certification requirements, and academic major courses.**

UNT Core: Communication

ENGL 1301; and ENGL 1302 or 2311

ENGL 1301 and ENGL 1302 are recommended for best preparation for state certification exams.

UNT Core: Language, Philosophy and Culture

One course chosen from: ARTS 1303, ENGL 2332 or 2333; HIST 2321 or 2322; PHIL 1301, 1304, 2303, 2306, or 2316

ENGL 2332 or 2333 is recommended for best preparation for state certification exams.

UNT Core: Mathematics

This requirement will be met by fulfilling the B.S. Education, EC-6 Certification program requirements.

MATH 1350 is recommended for best preparation for state certification exams.

UNT Core: Social & Behavioral Sciences

This requirement will be met by fulfilling the B.S. Education, EC-6 Certification program requirements.

TECA 1354 recommended for best preparation for state certification exams.

UNT Core: Life & Physical Sciences

This requirement will be met by fulfilling the B.S. Education, EC-6 Certification program requirements.

BIOL 1408, ENVR 1401, GEOL 1401, and PHYS 1415 are recommended for best preparation for state certification exams. (If all four Life & Physical Sciences courses are taken, two will be used to fulfill UNT Core: Component Area Option)

UNT Core: Component Area Option

This requirement will be met by fulfilling the B.S. Education, EC-6 Certification program requirements.

If all four Life & Physical Sciences courses listed are taken, two will be used to fulfill this requirement.

UNT Core: American History

Two courses chosen from: HIST 1301, 1302, 2301

HIST 1301 & 1302 are recommended for best preparation for state certification exams.

Education, EC-6 Certification: Program TCCNS Recommendations

- TECA 1311 [substitutes for EDEC 1010]
- TECA 1303 [substitutes for EDEE 1010]
- EDUC 1301 [substitutes for EDLE 2010]
- CDEC 1323 [substitutes for EPSY 2010]
- CDEC 1319 [substitutes for COUN 2600]
- CDEC 2371 [substitutes for LTEC 2600]
- CDEC 2315 [substitutes for EDDE 2050]
- CDEC 1356 [substitutes for EDRE 3350, but will not count toward advanced hours requirement]
- EDUC 2301 [substitutes for EDSP 3210, but will not count toward advanced hours requirement]

Courses listed above are TCCNS options and do not include all courses required for the UNT Education major.

UNT Core: Government/Political Science

GOVT 2305 and 2306

GOVT 2305 and GOVT 2306 are recommended for best preparation for state certification exams.

UNT Core: Creative Arts

One course chosen from: ARTS 1301 or 1304; DRAM 1310; MUSI 1306; SPCH 2341

ARTS 1301, MUSI 1306, or DRAM 1310 is recommended for best preparation for state certification exams.

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Early Childhood—6th Grade Teacher Certification

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Education, EC-6 Certification: Admission to Teacher Education Program

Admission to Teacher Education:

Students must be admitted to Teacher Education before enrolling in most education courses. For admission to elementary or middle school teacher education, a student must have:

- Active enrollment at UNT and a completed or in-process degree audit in the College of Education Student Advising Office;
- TSI Completion
- Approved Interview Questionnaire;
- Junior standing (60 credit hours earned); 12 earned credit hours in the certification field
- A 2.75 GPA (All Courses) AND a 2.75 UNT GPA with all courses complete;
- Application for Admission to Teacher Education upon completion of all requirements, above.

Continuation in the Teacher Education program is not guaranteed by the admission process.

Professional Development Sequence (PDS):

Students will participate in a Professional Development Sequence during the last three long semesters of their degree/certification program which requires they be available during normal public school hours. Courses taken during the second semester of PDS include both lecture classes and clinical practice. The third semester of PDS includes one or two lecture classes and 15 weeks of student teaching. Students must meet all prerequisites to participate in the PDS and public school clinical practice. A criminal history check is required prior to clinical practice.

Recommendation for Teacher Certificate:

All undergraduate students seeking recommendation for initial teacher certification through UNT must:

- Be admitted to Teacher Education at UNT;
- Successfully complete an approved teacher education program for the preparation of early childhood, middle grades, secondary or all-level teachers;
- Successfully complete student teaching, which includes attending appropriate seminars and passing a comprehensive teacher preparation examination; and
- Pass all required state certification exams; and
- Apply for teacher certification and complete fingerprinting.

Special Notes

Hours Required and General/College Requirements:

- A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Science degree as specified in the [general university requirements](#) section of the UNT catalog and the College of Education requirements.
- All core, certification requirement courses, and academic major courses must be completed with a grade of C or better and a minimum GPA of 2.75 in the completed core and academic major in order to advance to Professional Development Sequence.
- All core, certification requirement courses, academic major, and Professional Development Sequence courses must be completed with a grade of C or better for graduation.
- A minimum GPA of 2.75 in the completed core, academic major, and Professional Development Sequence courses; and a minimum GPA of 2.0 in UNT courses and GPA (all courses; includes all course work transferred plus that taken at UNT) is required for graduation.

UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum:

UNT complies with the [mandates of the 1997 Texas Legislature](#) regarding requirements for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

Choice of Catalog: Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.
