Courses Recommended for Transfer

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Kinesiology: Program Requirements

All tracks:

- BIOL 2401 (fulfills both Life & Physical Sciences core and program requirements)
- BIOL 2402 (fulfills both Life & Physical Sciences core and program requirements)
- MATH 1342 or 1442 or 2342 or 2442 (fulfills both Mathematics core and program requirements)
- PHED 1301 (substitutes for KINE 2030)
- PHED 1338 or KINE 1338 (substitutes for PHED 1000; fulfills a portion of CAO core and program requirements)
- HLTH 2200 at UNT (fulfills both Social & Behavior Sciences core and program requirements)

All-Level Teacher Certification track:

- PHED activity courses (selected in consultation with UNT advisor)
- HDFS 3423 at UNT (fulfills a portion of CAO core and major requirements)

Allied Health track:

- PHED 1306 (substitutes for HLTH 3300, but will not count toward advanced hours requirement)
- BIOL, CHEM, and PHYS courses below fulfill both Life & Physical Sciences core and program requirements.

Kinesiology: Teacher Certification Option

Admission to Teacher Education Program:

Prior to enrolling in the education courses, students must:

- be a junior (60 credit hours earned)
- have a 2.75 UNT GPA
- have a 2.75 overall GPA (includes courses transferred to UNT, plus all courses taken at UNT) $\,$
- have appropriate exam scores on either the SAT, ACT or TSI
- be actively enrolled at UNT and have a degree plan completed or in process in the Student Advising Office
- have completed the application process and been admitted to Teacher Education through the College of Education Student Advising Office in Matthews Hall, Room 105
- Approved Interview Questionnaire

Continuation in the Teacher Education Program is not guaranteed by the admission process.

Eligibility for Teacher Certification and Endorsements:

Teacher certification is a function of the State Board for Educator Certification. Completion of the bachelor's degree and the required education courses does not necessarily result in certification by the agency. In order to receive recommendation for teacher certification through the University of North Texas, students must have:

- fulfilled all requirements of an approved 124-hour degree plan
- received a grade of C or better for each kinesiology course and each PHED course
- obtained a 2.75 GPA in each of the following areas: each teaching field, all education courses, all UNT work, and overall (including transferred courses)
- successfully completed student teaching, including attendance at appropriate seminars and passing a comprehensive teacher preparation examination
- passed appropriate sections of the Texas Examinations of Educator Standards (TExES) $\,$

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Special Notes

Hours Required and General/College Requirements: A minimum of 120 semester hours (124 semester hours for those seeking all-level teacher certification), of which 36 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Science degree as specified in the general university requirements section of the UNT catalog and the College of Education requirements.

All kinesiology majors: A minimum grade of C is required in MATH 1342 or 1442 or 2342 or 2442; BIOL 2401 and BIOL 2402. A 3.0 GPA is required in PHED 1338 or KINE 1338; PHED 1301; KINE 2050; and KINE 2080 (available at UNT only) prior to a kinesiology major being allowed to take any KINE 3000- or 4000-level courses.

Non–Teacher Certification (General, Health Fitness Tracks, and Allied Health): A minimum grade of C is required in each course in the major; a minimum GPA of 2.75 in the major, 2.0 in UNT courses, and overall are required for graduation. (Overall GPA includes all course work transferred plus that taken at UNT.) Teacher certification: See requirements under "Teacher Certification Option".

UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum: UNT complies with the <u>mandates of the 1997 Texas Legislature</u> regarding requirements for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

Choice of Catalog: Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.

The College of Education required curriculum and policies are located in the <u>undergraduate catalog</u> under the corresponding catalog year.
