#### Courses Recommended for Transfer

The UNT Core requirements, with the exception of American History and the College & Major requirements, are shown with Texas Common Course Numbering System values only when UNT offers equivalent courses. There may be other courses in transfer that apply toward the specific degree requirement, but those listed are known to apply.

##### UNT Core: Communication

ENGL 1301; and ENGL 1302 or 2311

A grade of 'C' or better is required on courses applied toward this requirement.

##### UNT Core: Mathematics

This requirement may be met by fulfilling the Bachelor of Social Work major requirements (see next column).

##### UNT Core: Life & Physical Sciences

For students not majoring in Science, Mathematics, or Engineering, completing two courses from the list below is recommended (see an Academic Advisor for more options).

##### UNT Core: American History

Two courses chosen from: HIST 1301, 1302, 2301

##### UNT Core: Government/Political Science

GOVT 2305 and 2306

##### UNT Core: Creative Arts

One course chosen from: ARTS 1301 or 1304; DRAM 1310; MUSI 1306; SPCH 2341

##### UNT Core: Language, Philosophy and Culture

One course chosen from: ARTS 1303; ENGL 2332 or 2333; HIST 2321 or 2322; PHIL 1301, 1304, 2303, 2306, or 2316

##### UNT Core: Social & Behavioral Sciences

One course chosen from: ANTH 2346 or 2351; COMM 1307; CRIJ 1301; ECON 2301 or 2302; GEOG 1303; PSYC 2301; SOCI 1301; SOCW 2361; SPCH 1318; TECA 1354

*SOCW 2361 will fulfill both the Social & Behavioral Sciences core and Social Work major requirements.*

##### UNT Core: Component Area Option Category I

One course from this requirement will be met by fulfilling the Bachelor of Social Work major requirements (see column below). In addition, complete one course from Option A OR Option B.

**Option A:** ANTH 2346, 2351, or 2401; ARTS 1301, 1303 or 1304; ASTR 1403 or 1404; BIOL 1408 or 1413, or 2406; COMM 1307; CRIJ 1301; DRAM 1310; ECON 2301 or 2302; ENGL 1301, 1302, 2311, 2332, or 2333; HECO 1322; GEOG 1303; GEOL 1401 or 1403; HIST 1301, 1302, 2321, or 2322; MATH 1316, 1324, 1325 or 1425, 1332, 1342 or 1442 or 2342 or 2442, 1350, 2312 or 2412, 2313 or 2413 or 2513, 2314 or 2414; MUSI 1306 or 1307; PHIL 1301, 1304, 2303, 2306, or 2316; PHYS 1403, 1404, 1410, or 1415; PSYC 2301; SOCI 1301; SOCW 2361; SPCH 1315, 1318 or 2341; TECA 1354

**Option B:** SPCH 1311; TECA 1303

##### Social Work: Pre-major Courses and Application

Students must complete the pre-major courses and have at least a 2.25 cumulative GPA to apply to the BSW program. Admission to the Social Work major is on a space-available basis. Satisfying the GPA requirement and completing the pre-major courses does not guarantee admission to the program.

TCCNS options:

- SOCW 2361 (fulfills both Social & Behavioral Sciences core and program requirements)

**Application Process:** Completed application packets are due to the Social Work Program Coordinator within 30 days from the first day of the fall or spring semester. Students must meet with faculty advisor and follow a specific course sequence. See advisor for more details.

##### Social Work: Major Requirements

TCCNS options:

- MATH 1342 or 1442 (substitutes for UNT's SOWK 4880) (fulfills both Mathematics core and program requirements)
- *SOWK 4540, offered only at UNT, will fulfill part of the Component Area Option core requirement and the program requirement.*

*Courses listed above are TCCNS options and do not include all courses required for the UNT Social Work major.*

##### Social Work: Minor (optional)

A minor of 18 hours, including 6 advanced hours, is optional.

Suggested Minors: Behavior Analysis, Criminal Justice, Applied Gerontology, Human Services, Psychology, Sociology, Addiction Studies.

#### Special Notes

**Hours Required and General/College Requirements:** A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Social Work degree as specified in the [general university requirements](#) section of the UNT catalog and the College of Health and Public Service requirements.

**UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum:** UNT complies with the [mandates of the 1997 Texas Legislature](#) regarding requirements for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

**Choice of Catalog:** Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.
