## B.A. Communication Studies

### 2010-2011 Texas Common Course Numbering System Transfer Guide



- Entering students interested in majoring in communication studies will be classified as pre-majors and will be advised by the department.
- Admission to the university does not guarantee admission to the communication studies major. To be admitted to major status (and become eligible to enroll in certain advanced courses), a pre-major must meet the requirements listed in "Admission to the Major" on page two.
- The College of Arts and Sciences encourages students to explore teaching at the secondary level as a career option. Students seeking secondary teacher certification should contact the College of Education Office of Student advising.
- The College of Arts and Sciences expects students to have completed the Texas State recommended high school program and be ready to enroll in Language 2040 (TCCNS: Language 2311) or a mathematics course above college algebra. If you are not prepared for this level, the necessary prerequisites will either replace electives or increase the hours required for this degree.

### Courses Recommended for Transfer

#### UNT Core: English Composition & Rhetoric

ENGL 1301; and ENGL 1302 or 2311

A grade of 'C' or better is required on courses applied toward this requirement.

*ENGL 2311 is recommended.*

#### UNT Core: Mathematics

This requirement will be met by fulfilling College of Arts & Sciences mathematics requirement (see next column).

#### UNT Core: Natural Science

This requirement will be met by fulfilling College of Arts & Sciences laboratory science requirements (see next column).

#### UNT Core: U.S. History

Two courses chosen from: HIST 1301, 1302, 2301, 2327, 2328, 2381

#### UNT Core: Political Science

Two courses chosen from one of the following combinations:

- GOVT 2301 and 2302
- GOVT 2301 and 2305
- GOVT 2305 and 2306
- GOVT 2301 and 2306
- GOVT 2302 and 2306

#### UNT Core: Visual & Performing Arts

One course chosen from: ARCH 1301, 1302; ARTS 1301 or 1304; COMM 2366; DRAM 1310, 2361, 2362, 2363, 2366, 2367; DANC 2303, 2304; HUMA 1315; MUSI 1306, 1307, 1308, 1309

#### UNT Core: Humanities

One course chosen from: ENGL 2321, 2322, 2323, 2326, 2327, 2328, 2331, 2332, 2333, 2341, 2342, 2343, 2351; HUMA 1301, 1302; PHIL 1301, 2303, 2306, 2316, or 2317

#### UNT Core: Social & Behavioral Sciences

One course chosen from: ANTH 2346, 2351; CRIJ 1301; ECON 1301, 2301, 2302; GEOG 1302; HUMA 2323; PSYC 2301; SOCI 1301, 1306; TECA 1354

#### UNT Core: Understanding the Human Community

This requirement will be met by fulfilling College of Arts and Sciences foreign language requirement (see page two).

#### College of Arts & Sciences Core: Mathematics

Choose **one** course below (also satisfies the university core):

**Math 1350 and 1351 are not to be used to satisfy this requirement.**

#### College of Arts & Sciences Core: Laboratory Sciences

The College of Arts and Sciences requires students to complete at least 9 hours (3 courses) in laboratory science (6 hours/2 courses also satisfy the university core Natural Science requirement.) At least one course must be taken from the list of Natural and Life Sciences, at least one course must be taken from the list of Physical Sciences, and the third course can be taken from either the list of Natural and Life or Physical Science courses below:

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#### College of Arts & Sciences Core: Foreign Language

Any foreign language 2311 and 2312.

This also satisfies the university core Understanding the Human Community Requirement.

Latin courses (2311 and 2312) can be used to satisfy this requirement, but will not satisfy the university core Understanding the Human Community requirement. Courses must be taken in the same language.

NOTE: Prerequisites for foreign language 2311 and 2312 courses are 1311 and 1312 or 1411 and 1412 or 1511 and 1512. Placement exams may be available; see your community college academic advisor for details.

#### Communication Studies: Admission to the Major

To be admitted to major status (and become eligible to enroll in certain advanced courses), a pre-major must:

- complete at least 30 hours of college credit
- complete the university core English composition requirement (ENGL 1301 and 1302 or 2311) with a grade of C or better in each course
- complete SPCH 1311, 1318, 2341 and COMM 2140 (at UNT only) with a grade of C or better
- have a UNT grade point average of 2.5 or higher.

#### Communication Studies: Major Requirements

- SPCH 2341

*Courses listed above are TCCNS options and do not include all courses required for the UNT Communication Studies major.*

#### Teacher Certification Option

The College of Arts and Sciences encourages students to explore teaching at the secondary level as a career option. A higher GPA may be required for the certification option. For more information contact the College of Education Office of Student Advising at 940-565-2736.

#### Special Notes

**Hours Required and General/College Requirements:** A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Arts degree as specified in the "[General University Requirements](#)" in the [Academics](#) section of the UNT catalog and the College of Arts and Sciences requirements.

Students majoring in communication studies are required to have a minimum grade of C in all COMM courses to graduate.

**Minor Required:** Majors are required to complete a minor of at least 18 hours, including 6 advanced hours, from another department, or an interdisciplinary minor.

**UNT Core Curriculum:** Complies with the mandates of the 1997 Texas Legislature regarding requirements for state-assisted institutions. Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

**Choice of Catalog:** Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college
