2010-2011 Texas Common Course Numbering System Transfer Guide



- Entrance auditions and applications are required for admission to the BFA dance major in the dance program. Students are expected to enter the program on level III technique in Modern and Ballet as assessed by the departmental auditions. Transfer students entering the spring semester will be evaluated individually. Advancement to higher level technique classes is through teacher recommendation. At the end of each term/semester, students will be reviewed by the dance faculty to determine eligibility to continue in the BFA program.
- The College of Arts and Sciences expects students to have completed the Texas State recommended high school program and be ready to enroll in Language 2040 (TCCNS: Language 2311) or a mathematics course above college algebra. If you are not prepared for this level, the necessary prerequisites will either replace electives or increase the hours required for this degree.

Courses Recommended for Transfer

UNT Core: English Composition & Rhetoric

ENGL 1301; and ENGL 1302 or 2311

A grade of 'C' or better is required on courses applied toward this requirement.

UNT Core: Mathematics

One course chosen from MATH 1314 or 1414, 1316, 1324, 1325 or 1425, 1332, 1342 or 1442, 1350, 1351, 2312 or 2412, 2313 or 2413 or 2513, or 2314 or 2414

MATH 1332 or 1342 or 1432 is recommended.

UNT Core: Natural Science

This requirement will be met by fulfilling B.F.A. Dance major requirements (see next column).

UNT Core: U.S. History

Two courses chosen from: HIST 1301, 1302, 2301, 2327, 2328, 2381

UNT Core: Political Science

Two courses chosen from one of the following combinations:

- GOVT 2301 and 2302
- GOVT 2301 and 2305
- GOVT 2305 and 2306
- GOVT 2301 and 2306
- GOVT 2302 and 2306

UNT Core: Visual & Performing Arts

One course chosen from: ARCH 1301, 1302; ARTS 1301 or 1304; COMM 2366; DRAM 1310, 2361, 2362, 2363, 2366, 2367; DANC 2303, 2304; HUMA 1315; MUSI 1306, 1307, 1308, 1309

UNT Core: Humanities

One course chosen from: ENGL 2321, 2322, 2323, 2326, 2327, 2328, 2331, 2332, 2333, 2341, 2342, 2343, 2351; HUMA 1301, 1302; PHIL 1301, 2303, 2306, 2316, or 2317

UNT Core: Social & Behavioral Sciences

One course chosen from: ANTH 2346, 2351; CRIJ 1301; ECON 1301, 2301, 2302; GEOG 1302; HUMA 2323; PSYC 2301; SOCI 1301, 1306; TECA 1354

UNT Core: Understanding the Human Community

This requirement will be met by fulfilling B.F.A. Dance major requirements (two courses to be taken at UNT).

B.F.A. Dance: Other Course Requirements

- BIOL 2401 or 2301/1101
- BIOL 2402 or 2302/1102

Entrance auditions and applications are required for admission to the B.F.A. Dance major in the dance program. Students are expected to enter the program on level III technique in Modern and Ballet as assessed by the departmental auditions. Further information is available at www.danceandtheatre.unt.edu concerning time, date, and place.

B.F.A. Dance majors are expected to enroll in either ballet or modern technique courses every semester they are taking courses at UNT (excluding summers), completing a minimum of 24 hours of ballet and modern technique courses toward the major

Courses listed above are TCCNS options and do not include all courses required for the UNT B.F.A. major.

Special Notes

Hours Required and General/College Requirements:

A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Fine Arts degree as specified in the "General University Requirements" in the [Academics](#) section of the UNT catalog and the College of Arts & Sciences requirements.

To graduate, students majoring in dance are required to have a minimum grade of B in dance courses that comprise their major. Transfer course work to be substituted for required dance courses must be approved by a student's academic advisor during the degree audit process.

Students seeking a BFA in dance must maintain a cumulative grade point average of 2.5.

UNT Core Curriculum: Complies with the mandates of the 1997 Texas Legislature regarding requirements for state-assisted institutions. Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

Choice of Catalog: Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.
