The College of Arts and Sciences expects students to have completed the Texas State recommended high school program and be ready to enroll in Language 2040 (TCCNS: Language 2311) or a mathematics course above college algebra. If you are not prepared for this level, the necessary prerequisites will either replace electives or increase the hours required for this degree.

Courses Recommended for Transfer

UNT Core: English Composition & Rhetoric

ENGL 1301; and ENGL 1302 or 2311

A grade of 'C' or better is required on courses applied toward this requirement.

UNT Core: Mathematics

This requirement will be met by fulfilling the B.S. Geography mathematics requirement (see page two).

UNT Core: Natural Science

This requirement will be met by fulfilling the B.S. Geography laboratory science requirement (see page two).

UNT Core: U.S. History

UNT Core: Humanities

Foreign Language Option II:

Completion of two of the following course groups, in addition to the courses listed above. The two course groups (four courses in total) substitute for the foreign language requirement of the Arts and Sciences degree requirements.

Group I – Computer Programming and Information Systems.

Any two of the following: COSC 1315 or 1415, Program Development, 4 hours; Basic Information Systems (No TCCNS Options available), 3 hours; Visual Programming for Geographic Information Systems (No TCCNS options available), 3 hours.

Group II – Mathematics. Two courses (excluding MATH 1350), each at least 3 hours, in addition to the college requirement for meeting the Arts and Sciences degree requirements.

Group III – Physical and Natural/Life Science. Two advanced level courses, each at least 3 hours, in physics, chemistry or biology, subject to approval by the geography undergraduate advisor. Group III courses may be from different departments (for example, one in physics and one in chemistry). No TCCNS options available.

Students who select this option must also complete 6 hours from the approved list for Understanding the Human Community to satisfy university core requirements.

Courses listed below are TCCNS options and do not include all courses required for the UNT Geography major.

Special Notes

Hours Required and General/College Requirements:

A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Science degree as specified in the “[General University Requirements](#)” in the [Academics](#) section of the UNT catalog and the College of Arts & Sciences requirements.

UNT Core Curriculum: Complies with the mandates of the 1997 Texas Legislature regarding requirements for state-assisted institutions. Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

Choice of Catalog: Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.
