UNT Core: Political Science

Two courses chosen from one of the following combinations:

- GOVT 2301 and 2302
- GOVT 2305 and 2306
- GOVT 2301 and 2305
- GOVT 2301 and 2306
- GOVT 2302 and 2306

UNT Core: Visual & Performing Arts

One course chosen from: ARCH 1301, 1302; ARTS 1301 or 1304; COMM 2366; DANC 2303, 2304; DRAM 1310, 2361, 2362, 2363, 2366, 2367; HUMA 1315; or MUSI 1306, 1307, 1308, or 1309.

UNT Core: Humanities

One course chosen from: ENGL 2321, 2322, 2323, 2326, 2327, 2328, 2331, 2332, 2333, 2341, 2342, 2343, 2351; HUMA 1301, 1302; PHIL 1301, 2303, 2306, 2316, or 2317

PHIL 2317 fulfills both Humanities core and program requirements (see "Additional Elective Requirement").

UNT Core: Social & Behavioral Sciences

This requirement will be met by fulfilling the Anthropology program requirements (see "Required Courses" below).

UNT Core: Understanding the Human Community

This requirement will be met by fulfilling the Anthropology foreign language requirement (see below).

Anthropology: Required Courses

- ANTH 2302
- ANTH 2351 (fulfills both Social & Behavioral Sciences core and major requirements)
- ANTH 2401 or ANTH 2101 & 2301 (fulfills both a portion of the Natural Science core and major requirements)

Courses listed above are TCCNS options and do not include all courses required for the UNT Anthropology major.

Anthropology: Foreign Language Requirement

TCCNS options:

Foreign Language 1311 or 1411 or 1511; and 1312 or 1412 or 1512 (includes possibility of placement out by examination, see foreign language department for this information). Foreign Language options include: ARAB, CHIN, FREN, GERM, ITAL, JAPN, PORT, RUSS, and SPAN.

This also satisfies the university core Understanding the Human Community Requirement.

Anthropology: Additional Degree Information

A 2.0 grade point average must be maintained in all courses.

Transfer course work to be substituted for required anthropology courses must be approved by a student's faculty advisor during the degree plan process.

Special Notes

Hours Required and General/College Requirements: A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Arts degree as specified in the "[General University Requirements](#)" in the [Academics](#) section of the UNT catalog and the College of Public Affairs and Community Service requirements.

UNT Core Curriculum: complies with the mandates of the 1997 Texas Legislature regarding requirements for state-assisted institutions. Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

Choice of Catalog: Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.
