- The undergraduate program is designed for persons wishing to pursue graduate study in speech-language pathology and audiology and offers an avenue for students interested in pursuing other health professions, teaching, psychology, medicine, gerontology or law.
- Undergraduates are introduced to the clinical aspects of speech-language pathology and audiology through course work, clinical experiences and laboratory work at the UNT Speech and Hearing Center.
- The College of Arts and Sciences expects students to have completed the Texas State recommended high school program and be ready to enroll in Language 2040 (TCCNS: Language 2311) and a college level mathematics course. If you are not prepared for this level, the necessary prerequisites will either replace electives or increase the hours required for this degree.

Courses Recommended for Transfer

UNT Core: English Composition & Rhetoric

ENGL 1301; and ENGL 1302 or 2311

A grade of 'C' or better is required on courses applied toward this requirement.

UNT Core: Mathematics

This requirement will be met by fulfilling the BA Speech-Language Pathology/Audiology mathematics requirement (see next column).

UNT Core: Natural Science

This requirement will be met by fulfilling the BA Speech-Language Pathology/Audiology laboratory science requirement (see next column).

UNT Core: U.S. History

Two courses chosen from: HIST 1301, 1302, 2301

UNT Core: Political Science

Two courses chosen from one of the following combinations:

- GOVT 2301 and 2302
- GOVT 2301 and 2305
- GOVT 2305 and 2306
- GOVT 2301 and 2306
- GOVT 2302 and 2306

UNT Core: Visual & Performing Arts

One course chosen from: ARTS 1301, 1303, or 1304; DRAM 1310; MUSI 1306 or 1307; SPCH 2341

UNT Core: Humanities

One course chosen from: ENGL 2322, 2323, 2327, 2328, 2332, or 2333; PHIL 1304 or 2316

UNT Core: Social & Behavioral Sciences

One course chosen from: ANTH 2346 or 2351; COMM 1307; CRIJ 1301; ECON 2301 or 2302; HUMA 2323; PSYC 2301; SOCI 1301; SPCH 1318; TECA 1354

UNT Core: Discovery

One course chosen from: ARTS 1301; BIOL/HECO 1322; GEOG 1303; HIST 2321 or 2322; PHIL 1301, 2303, or 2306; SPCH 1311 or 1315; TECA 1303

UNT Core: Capstone

This requirement will be met by fulfilling the BA Speech-Language Pathology/Audiology major requirement (see next page).

College of Arts & Sciences Core: Foreign Language

Any foreign language 2311 and 2312.

Courses must be taken in the same language.

NOTE: Prerequisites for foreign language 2311 and 2312 courses are 1311 and 1312 or 1411 and 1412 or 1511 and 1512. Placement exams may be available; see your community college academic advisor for details.

Speech-Language Pathology/Audiology: Other Course Requirements

- BIOL 1413 or 1113/1313 ("C" or higher)
- MATH 1342 or 1442 or 2342 (fulfills mathematics core and major requirements)("C" or higher)
- PHYS 1410 or 1110/1310 ("C" or higher)
- CHEM 1405 ("C" or higher)(approved TCCNS substitute for CHEM 1360)

The BIOL, CHEM, and PHYS courses listed above fulfill both natural science core and major requirements.

Students majoring in speech and hearing sciences are required to complete 18 hours outside of the department. Students may elect one of the following:

- A minor of at least 18 hours, including at least 6 advanced; or
- 18 hours, including 9 advanced, selected from two or more departments outside speech and hearing sciences. The courses must be selected in consultation with the student's faculty advisor.

Students should have a degree audit prepared as soon as the major is declared. A GPA of 2.0 must be maintained in the major.

Courses shown below are TCCNS options and do not include all courses required for the UNT Speech Language Pathology/Audiology major.

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Speech-Language Pathology/Audiology: Major Requirements

No TCCNS options available.

SPHS 4065 (UNT only), required for the major, will also satisfy the UNT Core Capstone requirement.

- A 2.5 GPA in the major is required to graduate
- A "C" or higher is required on all SPHS courses. Students earning less than a "C" in any one of the SPHS courses will be allowed to retake the course only once.

Special Notes

Hours Required and General/College Requirements: A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Arts degree as specified in the "[General University Requirements](#)" section of the UNT catalog and the College of Arts and Sciences requirements.

UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum: UNT complies with the mandates of the 1997 Texas Legislature regarding requirements for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

Choice of Catalog: Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.
