- The College of Arts and Sciences encourages students to explore teaching at the secondary level as a career option. Students seeking secondary teacher certification should contact the Teach North Texas Program in the College of Arts and Sciences.
- The College of Arts and Sciences expects students to have completed the Texas State recommended high school program and be ready to enroll in Language 2040 (TCCNS: Language 2311) and a college level mathematics course. If you are not prepared for this level, the necessary prerequisites will either replace electives or increase the hours required for this degree.

## **Courses Recommended for Transfer**

The UNT Core requirements, with the exception of U.S. History and Political Science, and the College & Major requirements are shown with Texas Common Course Numbering System values only when UNT offers equivalent courses. There may be other courses in transfer that apply toward the specific degree requirement, but those listed are known to apply.

#### B.S. Biology: Major Requirements Teach

#### Teacher Certification Option

Only TCCNS options are shown:

- BIOL 1406\* or 1106/1306
- BIOL 1407\* or 1107/1307
- BIOL 2421 or 2321/2121

A grade of  $\ensuremath{\mathsf{'C'}}$  or better is required on courses applied toward this requirement.

 $\operatorname{BIOL}$  1406 and 1407 fulfill both Natural Science core and major requirements.

Courses listed above are TCCNS options and do not include all courses required for the UNT Biology major.

\*BIOL 1411 and 1413, if both completed prior to attending UNT, may substitute for BIOL 1406 and 1407.

### B.S. Biology: Minor in Chemistry (Required)

Minor of 20 hours in Chemistry is required. TCCNS Options:

- CHEM 1411 or 1111/1311
- CHEM 1412 or 1112/1312
- CHEM 2423 or 2123/2323 (approved substitution)
- CHEM 2425 or 2125/2325 (approved substitution)

A grade of 'C' or better is required on courses applied toward this requirement.

CHEM 1411 and 1412 fulfill both Natural Science core and program requirements.

#### **B.S. Biology: Other Course Requirements**

Only TCCNS options are shown:

- ENGL 2311 (fulfills both a portion of the English Composition & Rhetoric core requirement and program requirements)
- PHYS 1401 or 1101/1301
- PHYS 1402 or 1102/1302
- MATH 2312, or 2412 (fulfills both Mathematics core and program requirements)
- MATH 2313 or 2413 or 2513
- A minimum 2.5 grade point average must be maintained on all advanced courses in the division of sciences.
- A minimum 2.5 grade point average is required for graduation. Students in the department whose UNT or overall grade point average drop below 2.5 for two consecutive semesters will be removed from the program.
- Only two attempts will be allowed for each biology and biochemistry course in this degree.

#### **B.S. Biology: Advanced Coursework**

#### **Special Notes**

**Hours Required and General/College Requirements:** A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Science degree as specified in the "<u>General University Requirements</u>" section of the UNT catalog and the College of Arts and Sciences requirements.

### UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum: UNT

complies with the <u>mandates of the 1997 Texas Legislature</u> regarding requirements for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

**Choice of Catalog:** Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.
