## 2013-2014 Texas Common Course Numbering System Transfer Guide OF NORTH TEXAS®



The College of Arts and Sciences expects students to have completed the Texas State recommended high school program and be ready to enroll in Language 2040 (TCCNS: Language 2311) and a college level mathematics course. If you are not prepared for this level, the necessary prerequisites will either replace electives or increase the hours required for this degree.

## **Courses Recommended for Transfer**

The UNT Core requirements, with the exception of U.S. History and Political Science, and the College & Major requirements are shown with Texas Common Course Numbering System values only when UNT offers equivalent courses. There may be other courses in transfer that apply toward the specific degree requirement, but those listed are known to apply.

#### **UNT Core: English Composition & Rhetoric**

ENGL 1301; and ENGL 1302 or 2311

A grade of  $\mbox{{\sc 'C'}}$  or better is required on courses applied toward this requirement.

### **UNT Core: Mathematics**

This requirement will be met by fulfilling College of Arts & Sciences mathematics requirement (see next column).

#### **UNT Core: Natural Science**

This requirement will be met by fulfilling College of Arts & Sciences laboratory science requirement (see next page).

### **UNT Core: U.S. History**

Two courses chosen from: HIST 1301, 1302, 2301

These two courses will also fulfill 6 hours of major requirements; see page two for more information.

#### **UNT Core: Political Science**

As of Fall 2013, only the following courses are offered at the twoyear level:

GOVT 2305 and 2306

Other acceptable combinations are:

- GOVT 2301 and 2302
- GOVT 2301 and 2305
- GOVT 2301 and 2306
- GOVT 2302 and 2306

#### **UNT Core: Social & Behavioral Sciences**

One course chosen from: ANTH 2346 or 2351; COMM 1307; CRIJ 1301; ECON 2301 or 2302; HUMA 2323; PSYC 2301; SOCI 1301; SPCH 1318; TECA 1354

This course may also fulfill 3 hours of major requirements, depending on course selection; see page two for more information.

#### **UNT Core: Discovery**

One course chosen from: ARTS 1301; BIOL/HECO 1322; GEOG 1303; HIST 2321 or 2322; MATH 2305 or 2405; PHIL 1301, 2303, or 2306; SPCH 1311 or 1315; TECA 1303

This course may also fulfill 3 hours of major requirements, depending on course selection; see page two for more information.

## **UNT Core: Capstone**

The Capstone Core requirement is unique to UNT and will be fulfilled by an advanced course at UNT.

#### **UNT Core: Humanities**

One course chosen from: ENGL 2322, 2323, 2327, 2328, 2332, or 2333; PHIL 1304 or 2316

This course may also fulfill 3 hours of major requirements, depending on course selection; see page two for more information.

## College of Arts & Sciences Core: Foreign Language

Any foreign language 2311 and 2312.

Courses must be taken in the same language.

NOTE: Prerequisites for foreign language 2311 and 2312 courses are 1311 and 1312 or 1411 and 1412 or 1511 and 1512. Placement exams may be available; see your community college academic advisor for details.

#### **College of Arts & Sciences Core: Laboratory Sciences**

The College of Arts and Sciences requires students to complete at least 9 hours (3 courses) in laboratory science (6 hours/2 courses also satisfy the university core Natural Science requirement). At least one course must be taken from the list of Natural and Life Sciences, at least one course must be taken from the list of Physical Sciences, and the third course can be taken from either the list of Natural and Life or Physical Science courses below:

## **Social Science: Major Requirements**

Students must complete 48 semester hours of social sciences (24 of which must be advanced), and must include 18 hours in one field, plus 30 hours in at least two other fields. Fields are chosen from anthropology, economics, geography (regional science only), history, philosophy, political science (government), psychology, social work and sociology. Up to 24 hours of the following TCCNS subjects may count toward the major.

- ANTH
- ECON
- GEOG
- GOVT
- HIST
- PHIL
- PSYCSOCW
- SOCI

UNT core requirements for Political Science (GOVT) and U.S. History (HIST) will fulfill 12 hours of major requirements.

UNT core requirements for Humanities, Social & Behavioral Sciences, and Discovery may fulfill up to 9 hours of major requirements if courses are selected from the Social Science fields listed above.

# Special Notes

Hours Required and General/College Requirements: A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Arts degree as specified in the "General University Requirements" section of the UNT catalog and the College of Arts and Sciences requirements.

**UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum:** UNT complies with the <u>mandates of the 1997 Texas Legislature</u> regarding requirements for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

**Choice of Catalog:** Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college
