The bachelor's degree, emphasizing general educational preparation, represents a first step in preparing students for careers as information professionals. By combining a major in information science with an area of special interest in the context of new information technologies, students may be qualified for a variety of positions in information centers, bibliographic utilities and networks, information industry companies, and specialized publishing, abstracting and indexing services.

Students intent upon careers as information professionals should be prepared to undertake an additional year of study to earn the master's degree. It is the master's degree that is recognized as the basic professional degree and that is normally required for professional positions and continuing advancement in the field. The master's degree may be completed on a part-time basis, during which students may be employed in paraprofessional or other positions.

Courses Recommended for Transfer

The UNT Core requirements, with the exception of U.S. History and Political Science, and the College & Major requirements are shown with Texas Common Course Numbering System values only when UNT offers equivalent courses. There may be other courses in transfer that apply toward the specific degree requirement, but those listed are known to apply.

UNT Core: English Composition & Rhetoric

ENGL 1301; and ENGL 1302 or 2311

A grade of $\mbox{\ensuremath{\text{C}}}'$ or better is required on courses applied toward this requirement.

UNT Core: Mathematics

This requirement will be met by fulfilling College of Information Bachelor of Science mathematics requirement (see next column).

UNT Core: Natural Science

This requirement will be met by fulfilling College of Information Bachelor of Science laboratory science requirement (see page two)

UNT Core: U.S. History

Two courses chosen from: HIST 1301, 1302, 2301

UNT Core: Political Science

As of Fall 2013, only the following courses are offered at the twoyear level:

UNT Core: Capstone

The Capstone Core requirement is unique to UNT and will be fulfilled by an advanced course at UNT.

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College of Information Bachelor of Science Core: Laboratory Sciences

The College of Information requires Bachelor of Science students to complete at least 9 hours (3 courses) in laboratory science (6 hours/2 courses also satisfy the university core Natural Science requirement.) At least one course must be taken from the list of Natural and Life Sciences, at least one course must be taken from the list of Physical Sciences, and the third course can be taken from either the list of Natural and Life or Physical Science courses below:

College of Information Bachelor of Science Core: Foreign Language

Any foreign language 2311 and 2312. Courses must be taken in the same language.

NOTE: Prerequisites for foreign language 2311 and 2312 courses are 1311 and 1312 or 1411 and 1412 or 1511 and 1512. Placement exams may be available; see your community college academic advisor for details.

Information Science: Other Course Requirements

To enroll for more than 6 hours of courses in the Department of Library and Information Sciences, students must:

- Have at least sophomore standing (at least junior standing is required to enroll for more than 12 hours in the department)
- Have a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.5

There are no TCCNS options for Library and Information Science (SLIS courses).

Information Science: Minor (Required)

Minor of at least 18 hours, including at least 6 advanced hours, in an approved field outside the department.

Special Notes

Hours Required and General/College Requirements:

- A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Science degree as specified in the "General University Requirements" section of the UNT catalog and the College of Information requirements.
- A minimum grade point average of 2.5 is required on all courses counted toward the major.

UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum:

UNT complies with the <u>mandates of the 1997 Texas Legislature</u> regarding requirements for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

Choice of Catalog: Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.
