- Entering students interested in majoring in journalism will be classified as pre-majors and will be advised by the department. Admission to the university does not guarantee admission to the journalism major. To be admitted to major status (and become eligible to enroll in certain advanced courses), a pre-major must meet the requirements listed in "Admission to the Major" below.
- The Strategic Communications department includes advertising and public relations.

### **Courses Recommended for Transfer**

The UNT Core requirements, with the exception of U.S. History and Political Science, and the College & Major requirements are shown with Texas Common Course Numbering System values only when UNT offers equivalent courses. There may be other courses in transfer that apply toward the specific degree requirement, but those listed are known to apply.

#### Journalism: Admission to the Major

All Students wishing to pursue the BA major in journalism enter as pre-majors and before applying for major status, must complete at least 45 hours of college coursework including the following:

- COMM 1307, COMM 2311, JOUR 2000 at UNT with a 2.5 GPA or better
- Journalism Mathematics requirement: MATH 1342 or 1442
- University English composition requirement with C or better (ENGL 1301 and ENGL 1302)

Pre-majors who have completed the above requirements and who have a UNT GPA of at least 2.5 may file a formal application for major status. Approved majors may enroll in those advanced courses designated journalism major/minor only.

 Students must pass the Grammar, Spelling, Punctuation (GSP) exam (administered by the University Writing Lab at UNT) to be permitted to enroll in *JOUR 2310 at UNT*; students who transfer credit for COMM 2311 must take the Grammar, Spelling, Punctuation (GSP) exam during their first semester/ term at UNT.

Journalism Strategic Communications: Other Course Requirements

- MKTG 3650 at UNT is required for the Strategic Communications Concentration.
- Students majoring in journalism are required to maintain a 2.5 cumulative UNT GPA to graduate.
- A grade of C or higher is required for all journalism courses to be applied toward the major/minor requirements.
- Students who plan to obtain teacher certification should contact a faculty advisor to insure they have the necessary qualifications.
- No more than 12 semester hours of journalism credit will be accepted from a transfer student who is entering with less than 75 credit hours. For students transferring with 75 semester credit hours or more, a maximum of 18 transfer journalism hours will be accepted for credit toward the bachelor's degree.

# Journalism Strategic Communications: Other Course Requirements (Continued)

• A minimum of 72 semester credit hours must be completed outside of journalism. These 72 semester credit hours may not include RTVF.

# Journalism Strategic Communications: Minor Required)

Two options available:

- 18 hours of business courses consisting of MKTG 3010, 3650 and 4120 at UNT; plus 9 hours of upper-level marketing and/ or management classes approved by strategic communications
- 18 hour minor in another field of study.

### **Special Notes**

**Hours Required and General/College Requirements:** A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Arts degree as specified in the "General University Requirements" section of the UNT catalog and the Mayborn School of Journalism requirements.

#### UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum: UNT

complies with the <u>mandates of the 1997 Texas Legislature</u> regarding requirements for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

**Choice of Catalog:** Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.
