## B.F.A. Dance

### 2014-2015 Texas Common Course Numbering System Transfer Guide



Entrance auditions and applications are required for admission to the BFA dance major in the dance program. Students are expected to enter the program on level III technique in Modern and Ballet as assessed by the departmental auditions. Transfer students entering the spring semester will be evaluated individually. Advancement to higher level technique classes is through teacher recommendation. At the end of each term/semester, students will be reviewed by the dance faculty to determine eligibility to continue in the BFA program.

The College of Arts and Sciences expects students to have completed the Texas State recommended high school program and be ready to enroll in Language 2040 (TCCNS: Language 2311). If you are not prepared for this level, the necessary prerequisites will either replace electives or increase the hours required for this degree.

### Courses Recommended for Transfer

The UNT Core requirements, with the exception of American History and Government/Political Science, and the College & Major requirements are shown with Texas Common Course Numbering System values only when UNT offers equivalent courses. There may be other courses in transfer that apply toward the specific degree requirement, but those listed are known to apply.

#### UNT Core: Communication

ENGL 1301; and ENGL 1302 or 2311

A grade of 'C' or better is required on courses applied toward this requirement.

#### UNT Core: Creative Arts

This requirement will be met by fulfilling B.F.A. Dance major requirements.

#### UNT Core: Mathematics

One course chosen from: MATH 1316, 1324, 1325 or 1425, 1332, 1342 or 1442 or 2342 or 2442, 1350, 2312 or 2412, 2313 or 2413 or 2513

*MATH 1332 or 1342 or 1432 is recommended.*

#### UNT Core: Language, Philosophy and Culture

One course chosen from: ENGL 2332 or 2333; HIST 2321 or 2322; PHIL 1301, 1304, 2303, 2306, or 2316

#### UNT Core: Life & Physical Sciences

For students not majoring in Science, Mathematics, or Engineering, completing two courses from the list below is recommended (see an Academic Advisor for more options).

#### UNT Core: Discovery

This requirement will be met by fulfilling B.F.A. Dance major requirements.

#### UNT Core: American History

Two courses chosen from: HIST 1301, 1302, 2301

#### UNT Core: Capstone

This requirement will be met by fulfilling B.F.A. Dance major requirements.

*Note: The Core Capstone courses are under review by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board, and are subject to change.*

#### B.F.A. Dance: Other Course Requirements

Entrance auditions and applications are required for admission to the B.F.A. Dance major in the dance program. Students are expected to enter the program on level III technique in Modern and Ballet as assessed by the departmental auditions. Further information is available at [www.danceandtheatre.unt.edu](http://www.danceandtheatre.unt.edu) concerning time, date, and place.

B.F.A. Dance majors are expected to enroll in either ballet or modern technique courses every semester they are taking courses at UNT (excluding summers), completing a minimum of 24 hours of ballet and modern technique courses toward the major.

DANC 1100, offered only at UNT, is fulfill both Discovery and Dance program requirements.

DANC 4650, offered only at UNT, is fulfill both Capstone and Dance program requirements.

DANC 2800, offered only at UNT, is fulfill both Creative Arts and Dance program requirements.

*Courses listed above are TCCNS options and do not include all courses required for the UNT B.F.A. major.*

#### Special Notes

##### Hours Required and General/College Requirements:

A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Fine Arts degree as specified in the [General University Requirements](#) section of the UNT catalog and the College of Arts & Sciences requirements.

Students majoring in dance must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5, make a "B" or higher in dance technique courses and at least a "C" or higher in all other courses comprising the major. Transfer course work to be substituted for required dance courses must be approved by a student's academic advisor during the degree audit process.

##### UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum:

UNT complies with the [mandates of the 1997 Texas Legislature](#) regarding requirements for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

**Choice of Catalog:** Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.
