B.A. Dance: Other Course Requirements

- Entrance auditions are required for admission to be a B.A. Dance major in the dance program. Further information is available at <u>www.danceandtheatre.unt.edu</u> concerning time, date, and place.
- B.A. Dance majors are expected to enroll in either ballet or modern technique courses every semester they are taking courses at UNT (excluding summers), completing a minimum of 12 hours of dance technique courses toward the major.

B.A. Dance: Major Requirements

- DANC 1100, only offered at UNT, fulfills the Discovery Core requirement and a Dance program requirement.
- DANC 2800, only offered at UNT, fulfills the Creative Arts Core requirement and a Dance program requirement.
- DANC 4650, only offered at UNT, fulfills the Capstone Core requirement and a Dance program requirement.

Courses listed above are TCCNS options and do not include all courses required for the UNT B.A. Dance major.

Teacher Education Program

Admission to Teacher Education Program:

Prior to enrolling in the education courses, students must:

- be a junior (60 credit hours earned)
- have a 2.75 UNT GPA
- have a 2.75 overall GPA (includes courses transferred to UNT, plus all courses taken at UNT)
- have minimum THEA scores of 240 reading, 230 math, and 220 writing
- be actively enrolled at UNT and have an official degree audit with certification requirements included
- have completed the application process and been admitted to Teacher Education through the College of Education Student Advising Office in Matthews Hall, Room 105

Continuation in the Teacher Education Program is not guaranteed by the admission process. Exam #1 TExES: Pedagogy & Professional Responsibilities (EC-12)

Exam #2 TExES: Dance (8-12)

Additional requirements for Teacher Certification in Dance include a 2.75 overall GPA (including all transferred courses), a 2.75 UNT GPA, a 2.75 major GPA, and a 2.75 GPA in all Teacher Education courses.

Special Notes

Hours Required and General/College Requirements:

A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Arts degree as specified in the <u>General University Requirements</u> section of the UNT catalog and the College of Arts & Sciences requirements

Students majoring in dance must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5, make a "B" or higher in dance technique courses and at least a "C" or higher in all other courses comprising the major. Transfer course work to be substituted for required dance courses must be approved by a student's academic advisor during the degree audit process.

UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum: UNT

complies with the <u>mandates of the 1997 Texas Legislature</u> regarding requirements for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

Choice of Catalog: Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.
