- MATH 1325 or 1425, or MATH 2313 or 2413 or 2513 (fulfills both Mathematics core and major requirements)

### **Special Notes**

#### Hours Required and General/College Requirements:

A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Arts degree as specified in the <u>General University Requirements</u> section of the UNT catalog and the College of Arts & Sciences requirements

A student must earn at least a "B" in ECON 2301 and ECON 2302 and at least a "C" in all economics courses above the 3000 level. A student must earn at least a "B" in ECON 2302 before taking UNT's ECON 3550 and at least a "B" in ECON 2301 before taking UNT's ECON 3560. In all other cases, a student must earn a grade of "C" or higher in any prerequisite course before taking the next course in a sequence.

To graduate with a B.A. with a major in economics, a student must have a GPA of 2.5 in all economics courses (including transfer work). Students may retake UNT economics courses to improve the overall economics GPA. In computing the economics GPA, only the grade in the last repetition of a course will be included.

### UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum:

UNT complies with the <u>mandates of the 1997 Texas Legislature</u> regarding requirements for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

**Choice of Catalog:** Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.
