¹ Note on MULB 18xx courses: up to 4 hours of MULB (large performing ensemble) can be received in transfer, no TCCNS values established. All music majors must have a minimum of 4 semesters of MULB at UNT. All music degrees require a minimum of 8 semesters of MULB credit.

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- All students applying to the College of Music must audition and be accepted on their major performing instrument (or voice). Auditions are held early in the spring semester for the following year's admittance. Lessons from any other school are not automatically equivalent to UNT lessons.
- All Music majors are required to pass the UNT Music Theory Proficiency and the UNT Piano Proficiency for graduation. The lower level courses in piano, aural skills and music theory at UNT are designed to prepare students directly for these examinations. Students who transfer in these courses are responsible for all content covered in UNT courses. Students may choose to repeat theory and aural skills courses if not prepared for proficiency exams.
- All Music majors also must pass a computer proficiency, and the Upper Divisional Exam and Concentration Proficiency Exam in the principal instrument or voice.
- Music Composition majors must complete all required theory, aural skills and composition courses with no grade lower than B.

Courses Recommended for Transfer

The UNT Core requirements, with the exception of American History and Government/Political Science, and the College & Major requirements are shown with Texas Common Course Numbering System values only when UNT offers equivalent courses. There may be other courses in transfer that apply toward the specific degree requirement, but those listed are known to apply.

The following music proficiencies are required:

- Computer Proficiency
- Music Theory Proficiency
- Concentration Proficiency in the principal instrument or voice

College of Music: Admission to the Major

College Admissions Requirements: Admission to the College of Music is contingent on clear admission to the University. Entering transfer students interested in majoring in Music must qualify by audition on their principal instrument or voice. Preference will be given to applications received by April 1 for fall admission. For additional procedures and opportunities, please contact the College of Music.

Students unable to audition in person may submit a recording representative of their performance abilities.

Transfer students will take placement examinations in piano and possibly music theory at New Student Orientation.

Students transferring from other undergraduate music programs must meet the same requirements as new and continuing composition students in order to qualify for the composition program. Required course work will be determined in consultation with the <u>academic advisor</u> and composition division chair. Transfer students with at least two semesters of college-level composition courses who place into MUSI 2211/2311—MUSI 2116/2216 or higher may be eligible for **Intermediate Composition**. Consult with the composition division chair for specific criteria.

Composition majors also must successfully complete the Freshman Barrier Exam before beginning the second year of composition studies.

Hours Required and General/College Requirements: A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced,

minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Applied Arts and Sciences degree as specified in the <u>general university</u> <u>requirements</u> section of the UNT catalog and the College of Information requirements.

A minimum overall GPA (including all transferred courses) of 2.00 is required for graduation.

UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum:

UNT complies with the <u>mandates of the 1997 Texas Legislature</u> regarding requirements for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

Choice of Catalog: Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.
