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Courses Recommended for Transfer

UNT Core: Core Option Courses

One course for this requirement will be met by fulfilling the B.S. Hospitality Management (Hospitality, Nutrition and Food Science Teacher Certification) requirement. In addition, complete one course from Option A or Option B.

Hospitality Management: Major Requirements

TCCNS options:

- **TECA** 1303 (also fulfills a portion of the Core Option Courses core requirement)
- TECA 1354 (also fulfills the Social & Behavioral Sciences core requirement)

BIOL 1322 or HECO 1322 is an option for the major and also fulfills a portion of the Core Option Courses core requirement.

Courses listed above are TCCNS options and do not include all courses required for the UNT B.S. Hospitality Management (Hospitality, Nutrition and Food Science Teacher Certification) major.

Teacher Education Program

Prior to enrolling in the education courses, students must have:

- Completed a minimum of 60 semester hours, including the University Core Curriculum
- A 2.75 UNT GPA
- A 2.75 overall GPA (includes all courses transferred to UNT, plus all courses taken at UNT)
- TSI Complete Status, or have appropriate exam scores on either the ACT
- Formally applied and been admitted to Teacher Education through the College of Education Student Advising Office

Continuation in the Teacher Education Program is not guaranteed by the admission process.

Teacher Certification Information

No TCCNS options available.

Students must complete the required 21 hours in upper-level education courses and meet all GPA requirements to apply for state Certification. A 2.75 GPA is required on Teacher Education courses; see current UNT Undergraduate Catalog for all requirements.

To be certified to teach in the State of Texas, the student must successfully pass the following exams:

Exam #1 TExES: Pedagogy & Professional Responsibilities (Grades EC-12)

Exam #2 TEXES: Hospitality, Nutrition, and Food Science Concentration

Additional requirements for Teacher Certification in Hospitality, Nutrition, and Food Science include a 2.75 overall GPA (including all transferred courses), a 2.75 UNT GPA and a 2.75 major GPA.

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Special Notes

Hours Required and General/College Requirements: A minimum of 120-129 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Science degree as specified in the general university requirements section of the UNT catalog and the College of Merchandising, Hospitality and Tourism requirements.

UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum: UNT complies with the mandate of the Texas Legislature regarding Core Requirements for stateassisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

Choice of Catalog: Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.

The College of Merchandising, Hospitality and Tourism required curriculum and policies are located in the undergraduate catalog under the corresponding catalog year.
