## **Art History: Major Requirements**

# Art History core:

- ARTS 1303 (also fulfills Language, Philosophy and Culture core requirement)
- ARTS 1304 (also fulfills Creative Arts core requirement)
- ART 2370 (at UNT only) will fulfill a portion of Core Option Courses core requirement)

# Art History foreign language requirement:

- Foreign Language 2311 and 2312 (require prerequisite courses or placement exam)
- Language chosen should be relevant to your studies in art history.

# **Art History: Other Requirements**

- 24 advanced hours must be completed at UNT.
- 18 hours of art (including 12 advanced) must be completed at UNT.
- Transfer course work to be substituted for required art courses must be approved by a student's faculty advisor during the degree plan process.
- A 2.5 grade point average must be maintained in all art courses; only grades of C or better in art courses will count toward degree requirements

## Art History: Minor Required

A minimum of 18 hours, of which 6 must be advanced, from a field outside the College of Visual Arts and Design. Check with the minor department for specific requirements. The art history faculty strongly recommends that students in the foreign language relevant to their career plans in art history. Students double-majoring in art history and any other major are not required to have a minor.

# **Admission Requirements**

**Admissions to the Art History Major:** Students will be automatically admitted to the Art History Major. Students should see their advisor in their first semester to create a degree plan.

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# **Special Notes**

Hours Required and General/College Requirements: A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Arts degree as specified in the general university requirements section of the UNT catalog and the College of Visual Arts and Design requirements.

**Academic Requirements:** Art majors and art minors must take courses in sequence and must maintain at least a 2.5 grade point average in all art courses. Only grades of C (2.0) or better in art courses will count toward a student's degree requirements.

**Transfer Credits:** A transferred course must be reviewed for approval in order to be substituted for a required art course. Transfer credits in art from other schools can be substituted for UNT degree requirements only when content of the two courses is the same. Art core courses (Design I, Design II, Drawing I, Drawing II, Art History Survey I and Art History Survey II) are transferable from a Texas Community College. The student should provide a transcript of all college work so an advisor may better assist the student with course selection.

**UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum:** UNT complies with the mandate of the Texas Legislature regarding <u>Core Requirements</u> for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

Choice of Catalog: Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.

The College of Visual Arts and Design required curriculum and policies are located in the <u>undergraduate catalog</u> under the corresponding catalog year.
