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The College of Visual Arts and Design requires that all major courses taken must be completed with a grade of 'C' or higher.

Students wishing to major in any BFA program in the College of Visual Arts and Design will be initially classified as a pre-major. Additional qualifications will need to be met before being admitted into the full major of any BFA program.

Due to the highly sequenced curriculum, ARTE courses cannot be taken concurrently unless otherwise listed as such. This means that regardless of the require total remaining credit hours, students should anticipate a minimum of 2 years (4 Fall/Spring semesters) to complete the BFA in Art Education once they begin ARTE 3753.

To progress within the Art Education program, students must first complete 60 hours, including (but not limited to) the following: ARTS 1303, 1304, 1311, 1312, 1316, 1317, and either ARTS 2346 or 2347. ## Courses Recommended for Transfer

The UNT Core requirements are shown with Texas Common Course Numbering System values only when UNT offers equivalent courses. There may be other courses in transfer that apply toward the specific degree requirement, but those listed are known to apply.

### Art Education: Additional Requirements

In addition, students must also have the following:

- A minimum GPA of 2.75
- Successfully complete application to the College of Education while enrolled in ARTE 3753 at UNT
- 24 advanced hours completed at UNT
- 30 total hours must be completed at UNT
- 36 hours of art (including at least 12 advanced hours) completed at UNT
- Transfer course work substituted for required UNT art courses approved by a student's faculty advisor during the degree audit process
- A 2.75 grade point average maintained in all art courses; only grades of 'C' (2.0) or higher in art courses will count toward degree requirements
- A minimum certification GPA of 2.75 for all UNT and transfer course work
- A GPA of 2.75 on all certification courses (pass/no pass courses do not contribute to the GPA)



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#### Teacher Education Program

Prior to enrolling in the education courses, students must have:

- Completed a minimum of 60 semester hours, including the University Core Curriculum
- A 2.75 UNT GPA
- A 2.75 overall GPA (includes courses transferred to UNT, plus all courses taken at UNT)
- Completed the application process and been admitted to Teacher Education through the College of Education Student Advising Office in Matthews Hall, Room 105

*Continuation in the Teacher Education Program is not guaranteed by the admission process.*

#### Teacher Certification Information

No TCCNS options available.

Students must complete the required 21 hours in upper-level education courses and meet all GPA requirements to apply for state Certification. A 2.75 GPA is required on Teacher Education courses; see current UNT Undergraduate Catalog for all requirements.

To be certified to teach in the state of Texas, students must successfully pass appropriate state exams. Consult the College of Education TExES Success Office for specific exams requirements and information.

Additional requirements for Teacher Certification in Art include a 2.75 overall GPA (including all transferred courses), a 2.75 major GPA, and a 2.75 UNT GPA.

#### Special Notes

**Hours Required and General/College Requirements:** A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Fine Arts degree as specified in the General University Requirements section of the UNT catalog and the College of Visual Arts and Design requirements.

**Academic Requirements:** Art majors and art minors must take courses in sequence and must maintain at least a 2.75 grade point average in all art courses. Only grades of 'C' or higher in art courses will count toward a student's degree requirements. The teacher certification program for art education majors requires a 2.75 GPA in each area (academic major and pedagogy), and a 2.75 cumulative GPA on all UNT and transfer work.

**Transfer Credits:** A transferred course must be reviewed for approval in order to be substituted for a required art course. Art core courses (Design I, Design II, Drawing I, Drawing II, Art History Survey I and Art History Survey II) are transferable from a Texas Community College. The student should provide a transcript of all college work so an advisor may better assist the student with course selection.

**UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum:** UNT complies with the mandate of the Texas Legislature regarding [Core requirements](#) for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

**Choice of Catalog:** Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.
