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Courses Recommended for Transfer

UNT Core: Communication

This requirement will be met by fulfilling the B.A. Communication Studies major requirements.

UNT Core: Mathematics

One course chosen from: **BUSI** 2305; **MATH** 1324, 1325, 1332, 1342, 2312 or 2412, 2313 or 2413

UNT Core: Life and Physical Sciences

For students <u>not</u> majoring in Science, Mathematics, or Engineering, completing two courses from the list below is recommended (Consult UNT advisor for more options).

UNT Core: American History

Two courses chosen from: HIST 1301, 1302, 2301

UNT Core: Government/Political Science

UNT Core: Creative Arts

One course chosen from: ARTS 1301 or 1304; DRAM 1310; MUSI 1306 or 1307; SPCH 2341

SPCH 2341 is an option for the major and can be applied to this requirement (see next column).

UNT Core: Language, Philosophy and Culture

One course chosen from: **ARTS** 1303; **ENGL** 2321, 2326, 2331, 2341, or 2351; **HIST** 2321 or 2322; **PHIL** 1301, 1304, 2303, or 2306

UNT Core: Social and Behavioral Sciences

This requirement will be met by fulfilling the B.A. Communication Studies major requirements.

UNT Core: Core Option Courses

One course for this requirement will be met by fulfilling the B.A. Communication Studies major requirements. In addition, complete one course from Option A or Option B.

Option B: COMM 2302; **TECA** 1303

COMM 2140 (at UNT only) is an option for the major and can be applied to this requirement (see next column).

College of Liberal Arts & Social Sciences Core: Foreign Language

TCCNS options:

Any foreign language up through 2312

Courses must be taken in the same language.

Note: Prerequisites for foreign language 2312 courses are 1411, 1412, and 2311. Placement exams may be available; see your community college academic advisor for details.

College of Liberal Arts & Social Sciences Core: Distribution Requirement

No TCCNS options available.

Students pursuing the Bachelor of Arts degree must complete two courses (3 hours each) of advanced work at UNT in:

- Cultural Diversity & Global Issues: Focused on cultural diversity in regional, national or international contexts, depending on the nature of the course. 3 hours from an approved Study Abroad program can substitute for this requirement.
- Communication & Digital Skills: Focused on developing written, oral or visual communication skills using discipline-specific digital technologies.

Major courses can be used to satisfy both the CLASS Distribution requirement and your major requirements; see your academic advisor for assistance in making the best choice of CLASS Distribution courses.

Communication: Admission & Initial Requirements

To become eligible to enroll in certain advanced courses, a student must:

- Complete at least 30 hours of college credit
- Complete the university core Communication requirement (ENGL 1301 and 1302 or 2311) with a grade of 'C' or higher in each course
- Complete SPCH 1311, 1318, 2341 or COMM 3260, COMM 2140 or 3840, and COMM 3010 (at UNT only) with a grade of 'C' or higher in each course
- Have a UNT grade point average of 2.5 or higher

Communication: Major Requirements

TCCNS options:

- SPCH 1311 (also fulfills a portion of the Core Option Courses core requirement)
- SPCH 1318 (also fulfills the Social & Behavioral Sciences core requirement)
- SPCH 2341 (can also fulfill the Creative Arts core requirement)

COMM 2140 (at UNT only) is an option for the major and can fulfill a portion of the Core Option Courses core requirement.

Note: Students completing the Texas Direct Field of Study requirements for Communications should contact a UNT advisor for information on how those courses will transfer and apply to the Communication Studies major at UNT; email MassComm@unt.edu for details.

Courses listed above are TCCNS options and do not include all courses required for the B.A. Communication Studies major.



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Communication: Additional Requirements

A student who has completed 90 hours with at least a 3.5 grade point average is eligible to write a Senior Honors Thesis. Students who elect this option are expected to complete their theses in the course of a single term/semester.

Students majoring in communication studies are required to have a minimum grade of 'C' in all **COMM** courses that count toward the major to graduate. **COMM** courses taken beyond requirements for the major cannot be taken pass/no pass.

Students must observe prerequisites for each **COMM** course. If a student registered for a course has not completed prerequisite(s) for the course with a grade of 'C' or better, the student is subject to being dropped from the course without notice. Prerequisites are listed with individual course descriptions.

All students taking **COMM** 3010 may only take one additional **COMM** class concurrently, which must be approved by a Department of Communication Studies advisor.

Because of the high demand for many **COMM** courses, students who miss the first class day without prior consent of the instructor are subject to being dropped from the course so that other students may be added. It is the student's responsibility to secure prior consent of the instructor.

Communication: Required Minor

Students are required to complete a minor of at least 18 hours, including 6 advanced hours, from another department, or an interdisciplinary minor. Consult UNT advisor for TCCNS options.

Communication Studies: Teacher Certification Option

The College of Liberal Arts & Social Sciences encourages students to explore teaching at the secondary level as a career option. A higher GPA may be required for the certification option. For more information, contact your advisor.

Communication Studies: Grad Track Option

The B.A. Communication Studies major has a grad track option leading to a M.A. in Communication Studies. For more information, review the UNT undergraduate catalog and consult a UNT advisor.

Special Notes

Hours Required and General/College Requirements: A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Arts degree as specified in the General University Requirements section of the UNT catalog and the College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences requirements.

UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum: UNT complies with the mandate of the Texas Legislature regarding Core requirements for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

Choice of Catalog: Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.

The College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences required curriculum and policies are located in the <u>undergraduate catalog</u> under the corresponding catalog year.
