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Courses Recommended for Transfer

UNT Core: Communication

UNT Core: Social and Behavioral Sciences

UNT Core: Core Option Courses

This requirement will be met by fulfilling the B.A. English major requirements.

College of Liberal Arts & Social Sciences Core: Foreign Language

TCCNS options:

Any foreign language up through 2312

Courses must be taken in the same language.

Note: Prerequisites for foreign language 2312 courses are 1411, 1412, and 2311. Placement exams may be available; see your community college academic advisor for details.

College of Liberal Arts & Social Sciences Core: Distribution Requirement

No TCCNS options available.

Students pursuing the Bachelor of Arts degree must complete two courses (3 hours each) of advanced work at UNT in:

- Cultural Diversity & Global Issues: Focused on cultural diversity in regional, national or international contexts, depending on the nature of the course. 3 hours from an approved Study Abroad program can substitute for this requirement.
- Communication & Digital Skills: Focused on developing written, oral or visual communication skills using discipline-specific digital technologies.

Major courses can be used to satisfy both the CLASS Distribution requirement and your major requirements; see your academic advisor for assistance in making the best choice of CLASS Distribution courses.

English: Major Requirements

TCCNS options:

- ENGL 1301 and 1302 (also fulfills the Communication core requirement)
- ENGL 2321, 2326, 2331, 2341, and 2351 are options for the ENGL Literature 2000-level requirement (also fulfills the Language, Philosophy & Culture and a portion of the Core Option Courses core requirements)

ENGL 3000 (at UNT only) is required for the major and will fulfill a portion of the Core Option Courses core requirement.

Students must choose from concentrations in Literature, Writing and Rhetoric, Creative Writing, and Language Arts with Secondary Teacher Certification. No fewer than three 4000-level courses must be included in the concentration.

Note: The Texas Direct Field of Study in English Language & Literature can be applied to any concentration in this program. For more information, please visit the <u>Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) website</u> or consult your UNT advisor.

Courses listed above are TCCNS options and do not include all courses required for the B.A. English major.

English: Additional Requirements

A minimum grade of 'C' is required for all English courses counting toward the Bachelor of Arts degree with a major in English.

A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 is required for all English courses for graduation.

English: Grad Track Option

The B.A. English (Literature) major has a grad track option leading to a M.A. in English. For more information, review the UNT undergraduate catalog and consult a UNT advisor.



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Special Notes

Hours Required and General/College Requirements: A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Arts degree as specified in the General University Requirements section of the UNT catalog and the College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences requirements.

UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum: UNT complies with the mandate of the Texas Legislature regarding <u>Core requirements</u> for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

Choice of Catalog: Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.

The College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences required curriculum and policies are located in the <u>undergraduate catalog</u> under the corresponding catalog year.
