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The College of Visual Arts and Design requires that all major courses must be completed with a grade of 'C' or higher.

Students wishing to major in the Fashion Design program in the College od Visual Arts and Design (CVAD) will be initially classified as a Pre-Fashion Design major. To progress within the Fashion Design program, students must complete ADES 1550 (available at UNT in Fall semesters), ADES 1560 (available only at UNT in Spring semesters), ART 1311, 1312, 1316, and 1317. Students must also pass the Entry Portfolio review in the Spring before being fully admitted into the full major. Due to highly sequenced curriculum, ADES courses cannot be taken concurrently unless otherwise listed as such. This means that, regardless of the required total remaining credit hours, students should anticipate 4 years (8 Fall/Spring semesters) to complete the B.F.A. in Fashion Design. For this reason, community college students should consult with a CVAD advisor at the beginning of their academic career to establish expectations for time to degree completion after transferring to UNT.

Courses Recommended for Transfer

The UNT Core requirements are shown with Texas Common Course Numbering System values only when UNT offers equivalent courses. There may be other courses in transfer that apply toward the specific degree requirement, but those listed are known to apply.

Fashion Design: Additional Requirements

No TCCNS options available.

In addition, students must also have the following:

- 24 advanced hours must be completed at UNT
- 36 hours of art (including at least 12 advanced hours) must be completed at UNT
- Transfer course work substituted for required UNT art courses must be approved by a student's faculty advisor during the degree audit process
- A 2.5 grade point average must be maintained in all art courses; only a grade of 'C' (2.0) or higher in art courses will count toward degree requirements; this also applies to any transfer coursework used towards the major



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Fashion Design: Pre-Major

To be admitted to the fashion design major (and to be eligible to enroll in subsequent major-specific course work), a pre-major must meet all the following requirements:

Completed at least 30 hours of college courses (including those listed below) and have completed the following courses with a grade of 'C' or higher:

- ARTS 1311
- ARTS 1312
- **ARTS** 1316
- ARTS 1317
- ADES 1550 (at UNT only)
- ADES 1560 (at UNT only)

GPA Requirements:

- Have a minimum 2.50 GPA on the required art courses.
- Have a minimum 2.25 UNT GPA.

Portfolio Reviews:

 Fashion Design Entry Portfolio Review: Successful completion and passing of Entry Portfolio Review at the end of ADES 1560 is required for admission to major and subsequent courses in the degree.

Courses listed above do not include all courses required for the B.F.A. Fashion Design major. There are no TCCNS course options for UNT's Design (ADES) courses. ADES courses are offered only at UNT and must be taken in the order shown.

Special Notes

Hours Required and General/College Requirements: A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Fine Arts degree as specified in the General University Requirements section of the UNT catalog and the College of Visual Arts and Design requirements.

Academic Requirements: Art majors and art minors must take courses in sequence and must maintain at least a 2.5 grade point average in all art courses. Only grades of 'C' or higher in art courses will count toward a student's degree requirements.

Portfolio Review: All design and studio art majors require an entry portfolio review, which students must pass to continue in the major. Students who do not pass one or another of the successive required reviews should consult with their academic advisor regarding further options. Students should contact the department associated their major for specific expectations and procedures for all portfolio reviews.

Transfer Credits: A transferred course must be reviewed for approval in order to be substituted for a required art course. Art foundation courses (Design I, Design II, Drawing I, Drawing II, Art History Survey I and Art History Survey II) are transferable from a Texas Community College. The student should provide a transcript of all college work so an advisor may better assist the student with course selection.

UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum: UNT complies with the mandate of the Texas Legislature regarding <u>Core requirements</u> for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

Choice of Catalog: Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.

The College of Visual Arts and Design required curriculum and policies are located in the undergraduate catalog under the corresponding catalog year.
