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### **Courses Recommended for Transfer**

The UNT Core requirements are shown with Texas Common Course Numbering System values only when UNT offers equivalent courses. There may be other courses in transfer that apply toward the specific degree requirement, but those listed are known to apply.

#### **UNT Core: Communication**

A grade of 'C' or higher is required on courses applied toward this requirement.

#### **UNT Core: Mathematics**

One course chosen from: BUSI 2305; MATH 1324, 1325, 1332, 1342, 2312 or 2412, 2313 or 2413

#### UNT Core: Life and Physical Sciences

For students not majoring in Science, Mathematics, or Engineering, completing two courses from the list below is recommended (Consult UNT advisor for more options).

#### UNT Core: Language, Philosophy and Culture

This requirement will be met by fulfilling the B.A. History (Teacher Certification) major requirements.

#### **UNT Core: Social and Behavioral Sciences**

One course chosen from: ANTH 2346, 2351; BUSI 1307; COMM 1307; CRIJ 1301; ECON 2301 or 2302; GEOG 1303; PSYC 2301 or 2330; SOCI 1301; SOCW 2361; SPCH 1318; TECA 1354

#### **UNT Core: Core Option Courses**

This requirement will be met by fulfilling the B.A. History (Teacher Certification) major requirements.

#### College of Liberal Arts & Social Sciences Core: Foreign Language

**TCCNS** options:

Any foreign language up through 2312

Courses must be taken in the same language.

Note: Prerequisites for foreign language 2312 courses are 1411, 1412, and 2311. Placement exams may be available; see your community college academic advisor for details.

#### College of Liberal Arts & Social Sciences Core: Distribution Requirement

No TCCNS options available.

Students pursuing the Bachelor of Arts degree must complete two courses (3 hours each) of advanced work at UNT in:

- Cultural Diversity & Global Issues: Focused on cultural diversity in regional, national or international contexts, depending on the nature of the course. 3 hours from an approved Study Abroad program can substitute for this requirement.
- Communication & Digital Skills: Focused on developing written, oral or visual communication skills using discipline-specific digital technologies.

Major courses can be used to satisfy both the CLASS Distribution requirement and your major requirements; see your academic advisor for assistance in making the best choice of CLASS Distribution courses.

#### History (Teacher Certification): Major Requirements

TCCNS options:

- **HIST** 1301 and 1302 (also fulfills the American History core requirement)
- HIST 2321 (also fulfills the Language, Philosophy & Culture core requirement)
- HIST 2322 (also fulfills a portion of the Core Option Courses core requirement)
- HIST 2301 (approved substitute for HIST 3700 at UNT and also fulfills a portion of the Core Option Courses core requirement)

Note: HIST 2301 is not advanced-level credit. Students who take HIST 2301 may need additional advanced elective hours. Consult your UNT advisor for more information.

Note: The Texas Direct Field of Study in History can be applied to this program. For more information, please visit the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) website or consult your UNT advisor.

Students must finish a history course with a grade of 'C' or higher for it to count toward the major.

Courses listed above are TCCNS options and do not include all courses required for the B.A. History (Teacher Certification) major.

#### **History: Teacher Education Program**

Prior to enrolling in the education courses, students must have:

- Completed a minimum of 60 semester hours, including the University Core Curriculum
- A 2.75 UNT GPA
- A 2.75 overall GPA (includes courses transferred to UNT, plus all courses taken at UNT)
- TSI Complete Status, or have appropriate exam scores on either the ACT or SAT
- Completed the application process and been admitted to Teacher Education through the College of Education Student Advising Office

Continuation in the Teacher Education Program is not guaranteed by the admission process.

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#### History: Teacher Certification Information

No TCCNS options available.

Students must complete the required 21 hours in upper-level education courses and meet all GPA requirements to apply for state certification. See current UNT Undergraduate Catalog for all requirements.

To be certified to teach in the state of Texas, students must successfully pass appropriate state exams. Consult the College of Education TExES Success Office for specific exams requirements and information.

Additional requirements for Teacher Certification in History include a 2.75 overall GPA (including all transferred courses), a 2.75 UNT GPA, a 2.75 major GPA, and a 2.75 GPA in all Teacher Education courses.

#### **Special Notes**

Hours Required and General/College Requirements: A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Arts degree as specified in the General University Requirements section of the UNT catalog and the College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences requirements.

**UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum:** UNT complies with the mandate of the Texas Legislature regarding <u>Core requirements</u> for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

**Choice of Catalog:** Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.

The College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences required curriculum and policies are located in the <u>undergraduate catalog</u> under the corresponding catalog year.
