#### Interdisciplinary Arts & Design Studies: Additional Requirements

No TCCNS options available.

In addition, students must also have the following:

- 24 advanced hours must be completed at UNT
- 18 hours of art (including at least 12 advanced hours) must be completed at UNT
- Transfer course work substituted for required UNT art courses must be approved by a student's faculty advisor during the degree audit process
- A 2.5 grade point average must be maintained in all art courses; only a grade of 'C' (2.0) or higher in art courses will count toward degree requirements

## Interdisciplinary Arts & Design Studies: Required Minor

Students must pursue a minor outside of the College of Visual Arts and Design. Students should select a minor that corresponds to their ultimate career goal, such as anthropology, business, computer education, history, journalism, LGBTQ studies, management, marketing, merchandising, nonprofit leadership studies, or women's and gender studies.



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#### **Special Notes**

Hours Required and General/College Requirements: A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Arts degree as specified in the General University Requirements section of the UNT catalog and the College of Visual Arts and Design requirements.

**Academic Requirements:** Art majors and art minors must take courses in sequence and must maintain at least a 2.5 grade point average in all art courses. Only grades of 'C' or higher in art courses will count toward a student's degree requirements.

**Transferred Credit:** A transferred course must be reviewed for approval in order to be substituted for a required art course. Art foundation courses (Design I, Design II, Drawing I, Drawing II, Art History Survey I and Art History Survey II) are transferable from a Texas Community College. The student should provide a transcript of all college work so an advisor may better assist the student with course selection.

**UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum:** UNT complies with the mandate of the Texas Legislature regarding <u>Core requirements</u> for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

**Choice of Catalog:** Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.

The College of Visual Arts and Design required curriculum and policies are located in the <u>undergraduate catalog</u> under the corresponding catalog year.
