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All students applying for the Jazz Studies degree in the College of Music must audition and be accepted on their major performing instrument (or voice). Auditions are held early in the spring semester for the following year's admittance. Lessons from any other school are not automatically equivalent to UNT lessons.

All Jazz Studies majors are required to pass the UNT Piano Proficiency exam for graduation. The lower-level courses in piano at UNT are designed to prepare students directly for this examination. Students who transfer in these courses are responsible for all content covered in UNT courses.

All Jazz Studies majors must pass the Upper Divisional exam in the principal instrument or voice.

## Courses Recommended for Transfer

The UNT Core requirements are shown with Texas Common Course Numbering System values only when UNT offers equivalent courses. There may be other courses in transfer that apply toward the specific degree requirement, but those listed are known to apply.

### UNT Core: Communication

**ENGL 1301**; and **ENGL 1302** or **2311**

A grade of 'C' or higher is required on courses applied toward this requirement.

*ENGL 1301 and 1302 are recommended.*

### UNT Core: Mathematics

One course chosen from: **BUSI 2305**; **MATH 1324, 1325, 1332, 1342, 2312** or **2412, 2313** or **2413**

*MATH 1332 is recommended.*

### UNT Core: Life and Physical Sciences

One course for this requirement will be met by fulfilling the B.M. Jazz Studies (Instrumental Emphasis) major requirements. In addition, complete one course from the list below (Consult UNT advisor for more options).

### Jazz Studies (Instrumental): Additional Requirements

Keyboard majors must pass OpenScore/Transposition Exam.

To enroll in upper division coursework in their emphasis majors must complete **MUJS 2370** (UNT only) with a grade of 'C' or higher.

A minimum 2.75 GPA in all music courses is required.

Students majoring in jazz studies must also abide by the policies and procedures set forth in the Jazz Studies Student Handbook.

### Jazz Studies (Instrumental): Required Africana Studies Certificate

The following UNT courses, which are required for the Bachelor of Music in jazz studies, also meet the criteria for the Africana studies certificate offered through the Department of History:

- **HIST 3240** - African American History and Culture to 1865
- **HIST 3250** - African American History and Culture Since 1865
- **MUET 3060** - African-American Music
- **MUJS 3070** - History of Jazz

Therefore, by virtue of completing the requirements for the B.M. Jazz Studies, students will also receive the Africana studies certificate from the Department of History.

### Jazz Studies (Instrumental): Optional Commercial Music Minor

The structure of the B.M. Jazz Studies allows students to complete the commercial music minor (18 hours) without exceeding the 129 degree hours. The minor is optional but can be pursued within the B.M. Jazz Studies in the following manner:

- Complete **MUAE 3100** - Introduction to Digital Audio Workstation Techniques (required for the Jazz Studies, BM).
- Use the 9 elective hours within the degree to complete 3 of the required courses for the commercial music minor, which are **MUAE 3200**, **MUAE 3950**, and **MUAE 4200**.
- Enroll in at least 3 hours of **MULB 1819** (counts towards required 8 hours of MULB credit).
- Students may substitute **MUJS 4720** for **MUAE 4500** with approval of the commercial music minor supervisor and the major professor in the Division of Jazz Studies. Students pursuing this substitution will be required to create a solo album or EP as part of **MUJS 4720**, either in lieu of or in addition to a live recital.



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#### College of Music: Admission Requirements

Admission to the College of Music is contingent on clear admission to the university. Those students who intend to be Jazz Studies majors must qualify by audition on their principal instrument or voice. Preference will be given to applications received by December 1 for fall admission. For additional procedures and opportunities, please contact the College of Music.

Prospective Jazz Studies majors should closely follow audition repertoire information from the College of Music Jazz Studies website. This may include auditioning with both classical and jazz repertoire depending on your instrument.

Students unable to audition in person may submit a recording representative of their performance abilities.

All students will have the opportunity to take a placement examination in piano after attending orientation.

#### Special Notes

**Hours Required and General/College Requirements:** A minimum of 129 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Music degree as specified in the General University Requirements section of the UNT catalog and the College of Music requirements.

**UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum:** UNT complies with the mandate of the Texas Legislature regarding [Core requirements](#) for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as “core complete” for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

**Choice of Catalog:** Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.
