## **Courses Recommended for Transfer**

The UNT Core requirements are shown with Texas Common Course Numbering System values only when UNT offers equivalent courses. There may be other courses in transfer that apply toward the specific degree requirement, but those listed are known to apply.

#### **UNT Core: Communication**

ENGL 1301; and ENGL 1302 or 2311

A grade of 'C' or higher is required on courses applied toward this requirement.

#### **UNT Core: Mathematics**

This requirement will be met by fulfilling the B.S. Kinesiology (General Track) major requirements.

#### **UNT Core: Life and Physical Sciences**

For students <u>not</u> majoring in Science, Mathematics, or Engineering, completing two courses from the list below is recommended (Consult UNT advisor for more options).

#### **UNT Core: Creative Arts**

### UNT Core: Language, Philosophy and Culture

This requirement will be met by fulfilling the B.S. Kinesiology (General Track) major requirements.

#### UNT Core: Social and Behavioral Sciences

This requirement will be met by fulfilling the B.S. Kinesiology (General Track) major requirements.

### **UNT Core: Core Option Courses**

This requirement will be met by fulfilling the B.S. Kinesiology (General Track) major requirements.

One course for this requirement will be met by fulfilling the B.S. Psychology major requirements. In addition, complete one course from Core Option A OR Option B.

## Kinesiology (General Track): Major Requirements

TCCNS options:

- PHED 1301 or KINE 1301 (approved substitution)
- PHED 1338 (approved substitution and also fulfills a portion of the Core Option Courses core requirement)

Courses listed above are TCCNS options and do not include all courses required for the B.S. Kinesiology (General Track) major.



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## Kinesiology (General Track): Additional Requirements

#### TCCNS options:

- BIOL 2101 & 2301, or 2401 (also fulfills a portion of the Life & Physical Sciences core requirement)
- BIOL 2102 & 2302, or 2402 (also fulfills a portion of the Life & Physical Sciences core requirement)
- MATH 1342 (also fulfills the Mathematics core requirement)
- KINE 2050 (at UNT only) (also fulfils the Language, Philosophy and Culture core requirement)

To move into Tier 2, you must have completed each course in Tier 1 with a minimum grade of 'C' and have a 2.5 overall GPA or overall.

To take any additional upper-division **KINE** courses, you must have completed each course in Tier 2 with a minimum grade of 'C' and have a 2.5 overall GPA or higher.

A kinesiology course may be repeated one time in order to improve a grade to the requirement of a 'C' or higher. Following the second attempt, approval for a third attempt must be sought from the program coordinator or department.

A minimum grade of 'C' is required in each course in the major. A minimum GPA of 2.75 in the major, 2.0 in UNT courses, and overall is required for graduation. (Overall GPA includes all coursework transferred plus that taken at UNT.)

12 hours of KINE must be taken at UNT.

36 hours must be advanced; 24 of which must be taken at UNT.

Courses listed above are TCCNS options and do not include all courses required for the B.S. Kinesiology (General Track) major.

#### Kinesiology (General Track): Required Minor

Minimum of 18 hours from area other than kinesiology, 6 of which must be advanced.

#### Kinesiology: Grad Track Option

The B.S. Kinesiology major has a grad track option leading to a M.S. Kinesiology. For more information, review the UNT undergraduate catalog and consult a UNT advisor.

#### **Special Notes**

Hours Required and General/College Requirements: A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 36 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Science degree as specified in the General University Requirements section of the UNT catalog and the College of Education requirements.

**UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum:** UNT complies with the mandate of the Texas Legislature regarding <u>Core requirements</u> for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

**Choice of Catalog:** Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.
