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Courses Recommended for Transfer

College of Liberal Arts & Social Sciences Core: Foreign Language

This requirement will be met by fulfilling the B.A. Spanish major requirements.

College of Liberal Arts & Social Sciences Core: Distribution Requirement

No TCCNS options available.

Students pursuing the Bachelor of Arts degree must complete two courses (3 hours each) of advanced work at UNT in:

- **Cultural Diversity & Global Issues:** This requirement will be met by fulfilling the B.A. Spanish major requirements.
- **Communication & Digital Skills:** Focused on developing written, oral or visual communication skills using discipline-specific digital technologies.

Major courses can be used to satisfy both the CLASS Distribution requirement and your major requirements; see your academic advisor for assistance in making the best choice of CLASS Distribution courses.

Spanish: Major Requirements

TCCNS options:

- **SPAN 1411**
- **SPAN 1412**
- **SPAN 2311**
- **SPAN 2312**

Placement or credit by exam may be used to satisfy the courses listed above.

SPAN 1030 (at UNT only) may be used in place of **SPAN 1411** and **1412** if the student has taken two years of high school Spanish or equivalent.

SPAN 3110 (at UNT only) is required for the major and will fulfill the Cultural Diversity & Global Issues portion of the Distribution requirement.

Courses listed above are TCCNS options and do not include all courses required for the B.A. Spanish major.

Spanish: Additional Requirements

Students majoring in Spanish should consider taking history and geography courses that deal specifically with their language study.

A minimum grade of 'C' is required for a course to count toward the major.

Minimum GPA of 2.75 in Spanish course work is required for graduation.

Spanish: Optional Minor

Students who wish to earn a minor are encouraged to choose a second foreign language. Spanish majors should also consider history, geography, business, hospitality management and cultural studies courses that deal specifically with their area of interest.

Spanish: Teacher Certification Program

The College of Liberal Arts & Social Sciences encourages students to explore teaching at the secondary level as a career option. A higher GPA may be required for the certification option. For more information, consult a UNT advisor.

Spanish: Grad Track Option

The B.A. Spanish major has a grad track option leading to a M.A. in Spanish. For more information, review the UNT undergraduate catalog and consult a UNT advisor.



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Special Notes

Hours Required and General/College Requirements: A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Arts degree as specified in the General University Requirements section of the UNT catalog and the College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences requirements.

UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum: UNT complies with the mandate of the Texas Legislature regarding [Core requirements](#) for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as “core complete” for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

Choice of Catalog: Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.
