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The College of Visual Arts and Design (CVAD) requires that all courses in the college taken towards the major must be completed with a grade of 'C' or higher.

In addition to the university admission requirements, students wishing to major in any Studio Art concentrations within CVAD will be initially classified as a Pre-Studio Art major. Only after completing the Entry Portfolio Review for their desired concentration will a student be admitted into the full Studio Art major. Studio Art programs have strict course sequencing, and some required lower-level art courses are not offered at the community college. For this reason, community college students should consult with a CVAD advisor at the beginning of their academic career to establish expectations for time to degree completion after transferring to UNT.

Courses Recommended for Transfer

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Studio Art (Metalsmithing & Jewelry): Additional Requirements

No TCCNS options available.

- In addition, students must also have the following:
 - 24 advanced hours must be completed at UNT
 - 36 hours of art (including at least 12 advanced hours) must be completed at UNT
 - Transfer course work substituted for required UNT art courses must be approved by a student's faculty advisor during the degree audit process
 - A 2.5 grade point average must be maintained in all art courses; only a grade of 'C' (2.0) or higher in art courses will count toward degree requirements

For all students seeking a major in the College of Visual Arts and Design, a grade of 'C' or higher must be earned in every art-based course required in the College of Visual Arts and Design (completed in residence or transferred to UNT) to be considered for credit toward a CVAD degree. A grade of 'D' or lower will not satisfy any art-based course requirements, electives or prerequisites.

Additionally, the required 6 credits of **ASTU** 4400 (at UNT only) must be taken over two semesters.

Studio Art (Metalsmithing & Jewelry): Pre-Major

To be admitted to the Studio Art major (and to be eligible to enroll in advanced art courses), a pre-major must meet all of the following requirements:

Completed at least 30 hours of college courses (including those listed below) and have completed the following courses with a grade of 'C' or higher:

- **ARTS** 1311
- **ARTS** 1312
- **ARTS** 1316
- **ARTS** 1317

Students interested in majoring in Studio Art must also complete at least 9 hours (three courses) of 2000-level or higher studio art courses with a grade of 'C' or higher. One course must be from the Metalsmithing & Jewelry concentration with a grade of 'B' or higher.

GPA Requirements:

Have a minimum 2.50 GPA

Portfolio Reviews:

 Studio Art Metalsmithing & Jewelry Entry Portfolio Review: Successful completion and passing of Entry Portfolio Review is required for admission to major and subsequent courses in the degree.

Special Notes

Hours Required and General/College Requirements: A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Fine Arts degree as specified in the General University Requirements section of the UNT catalog and the College of Visual Arts and Design requirements.

Academic Requirements: Art majors and art minors must take courses in sequence and must maintain at least a 2.5 grade point average in all art courses. Only grades of 'C' or higher in art courses will count toward a student's degree requirements.

Portfolio Review: All design and studio art majors require an entry portfolio review, which students must pass to continue in the major. Students who do not pass one or another of the successive required reviews should consult with their academic advisor regarding further options. Students should contact the department associated their major for specific expectations and procedures for all portfolio reviews.

Transfer Credits: A transferred course must be reviewed for approval in order to be substituted for a required art course. Art foundation courses (Design I, Design II, Drawing I, Drawing II, Art History Survey I and Art History Survey II) are transferable from a Texas Community College. The student should provide a transcript of all college work so an advisor may better assist the student with course selection.

UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum: UNT complies with the mandate of the Texas Legislature regarding <u>Core requirements</u> for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

Choice of Catalog: Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.

The College of Visual Arts and Design required curriculum and policies are located in the <u>undergraduate catalog</u> under the corresponding catalog year.
