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Courses Recommended for Transfer

Students pursuing the Bachelor of Arts degree must complete two courses (3 hours each) of advanced work at UNT in:

- Cultural Diversity & Global Issues: This requirement will be met by fulfilling the B.A. Theatre (Teacher Certification) major requirements.
- Communication & Digital Skills: Focused on developing written, oral or • visual communication skills using discipline-specific digital technologies.

Theatre (Teacher Certification): Major Requirements

THEA 3030 (at UNT only) is required for the major and will fulfill the Creative Arts core requirement.

THEA 3040 (at UNT only) is required for the major and will fulfill a portion of the Core Option Courses core requirement and the Cultural Diversity & Global Issues portion of the Distribution requirement.

Note: The Texas Direct Field of Study in Drama can be applied to any concentration in this program. For more information, please visit the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) website or consult your UNT advisor.

A grade of 'C' or higher is required in all Theatre courses that compromise the Theatre major.

Courses listed above are TCCNS options and do not include all courses required for the B.A. Theatre (Teacher Certification) major.

Theatre (Teacher Certification): Additional Requirements

To remain a theatre major and to graduate, students majoring in theatre must maintain a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 for all theatre courses.

Students majoring in theatre must enroll in a production course (THEA 4500 or equivalent at UNT) each term/semester the student performs or designs in public productions sponsored or approved by the department.

Transfer work to be substituted for required theatre courses must be approved by the departmental advisor.

The department does not allow students to obtain a 'D' or below more than twice in a theatre course comprising the major. Once the student receives the second 'D' or below in the same course, the student will be dismissed from the department.

Students who miss the first day of class without consent of the instructor are subject to be administratively dropped from the course so that other students may be added. Students who miss the first day of class because of illness or some other acceptable excuse must notify the instructor on record the day of the absence.

Students must observe prerequisites for each theatre course. If a student has not completed prerequisites for a particular course, the student is subject to administrative drop without notice. Prerequisites are listed with individual course descriptions.

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Theatre: Teacher Education Program

Prior to enrolling in the education courses, students must have:

- Completed a minimum of 60 semester hours, including the University Core Curriculum
- A 2.75 UNT GPA
- A 2.75 overall GPA (includes courses transferred to UNT, plus all courses taken at UNT)
- TSI Complete Status, or have appropriate exam scores on either the ACT or SAT
- Completed the application process and been admitted to Teacher Education through the College of Education Student Advising Office

Continuation in the Teacher Education Program is not guaranteed by the admission process.

Theatre: Teacher Certification Information

No TCCNS options available.

Students must complete the required 21 hours in upper-level education courses and meet all GPA requirements to apply for state certification. See current UNT Undergraduate Catalog for all requirements.

To be certified to teach in the state of Texas, students must successfully pass appropriate state exams. Consult the College of Education TExES Success Office for specific exams requirements and information.

Additional requirements for Teacher Certification in Theatre include a 2.75 overall GPA (including all transferred courses), a 2.75 UNT GPA, a 2.75 major GPA, and a 2.75 GPA in all Teacher Education courses.

Special Notes

Hours Required and General/College Requirements: A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Arts degree as specified in the General University Requirements section of the UNT catalog and the College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences requirements.

UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum: UNT complies with the mandate of the Texas Legislature regarding <u>Core requirements</u> for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

Choice of Catalog: Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.

The College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences required curriculum and policies are located in the <u>undergraduate catalog</u> under the corresponding catalog year.
