College of Liberal Arts & Social Sciences Core: Foreign Language

TCCNS options:

Any foreign language up through 2312

Courses must be taken in the same language.

Note: Prerequisites for foreign language 2312 courses are 1411, 1412, and 2311. Placement exams may be available; see your community college academic advisor for details.

College of Liberal Arts & Social Sciences Core: Distribution Requirement

No TCCNS options available.

Students pursuing the Bachelor of Arts degree must complete two courses (3 hours each) of advanced work at UNT in:

- Cultural Diversity & Global Issues: Focused on cultural diversity in regional, national or international contexts, depending on the nature of the course. 3 hours from an approved Study Abroad program can substitute for this requirement.
- Communication & Digital Skills: This requirement will be met by fulfilling the B.A. English (Teacher Certification) major requirements.

Major courses can be used to satisfy both the CLASS Distribution requirement and your major requirements; see your academic advisor for assistance in making the best choice of CLASS Distribution courses.

English (Teacher Certification): Major Requirements

TCCNS options:

- COMM 1307 (also fulfills the Social & Behavioral Sciences core requirement)
- ENGL 1301 and 1302 (also fulfills the Communication core requirement)
- ENGL 2307, 2321, 2326, 2331, 2341, and 2351 are options for the Foundation requirement (also fulfills the Language, Philosophy & Culture core requirement)
- SPCH 1311 (also fulfills a portion of the Core Option Courses core requirement)

ENGL 3110 (at UNT only) is required for the major and will fulfill the Communication & Digital Skills portion of the Distribution requirement.

LING 3060 (at UNT only) is required for the major and will fulfill a portion of the Core Option Courses core requirement.

Note: The Texas Direct Field of Study in English Language & Literature can be applied to this program. For more information, please visit the <u>Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) website</u> or consult your UNT advisor.

Courses listed above are TCCNS options and do not include all courses required for the B.A. English (Teacher Certification) major.

English (Teacher Certification): Additional Requirements

A minimum grade of 'C' is required for all English/Linguistics courses counting toward the Bachelor of Arts degree in English.

A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 is required for all English/Linguistics courses for graduation.

Students must also complete teacher certification requirements.

English: Teacher Education Program Admission Requirements

Prior to enrolling in the education courses, students must have:

- Completed a minimum of 60 semester hours, including the University Core Curriculum
- A 2.75 UNT GPA
- A 2.75 overall GPA (includes courses transferred to UNT, plus all courses taken at UNT)
- TSI Complete Status, or have appropriate exam scores on either the ACT or SAT
- Completed the application process and been admitted to Teacher Education through the College of Education Student Advising Office

Continuation in the Teacher Education Program is not guaranteed by the admission process.

English: Additional Teacher Education Program Requirements

TCCNS options:

- EDUC 1301 (approved substitution for EDCI 3800 at UNT)
- EDUC 2301 (approved substitution for EDCI 4070 at UNT)

Note: EDUC 1301 and **EDUC** 2301 are not advanced-level credit. Students who take these courses may need additional advanced elective hours. Consult your UNT advisor for more information.

Students must complete the required 21 hours in upper-level education courses and meet all GPA requirements to apply for state certification. See current UNT Undergraduate Catalog for all requirements.

To be certified to teach in the state of Texas, students must successfully pass appropriate state exams. Consult the College of Education TEXES Success Office for specific exams requirements and information.

Additional requirements for Teacher Certification in English include a 2.75 overall GPA (including all transferred courses), a 2.75 UNT GPA, a 2.75 major GPA, and a 2.75 GPA in all Teacher Education courses.

Special Notes

Hours Required and General/College Requirements: A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Arts degree as specified in the General University Requirements section of the UNT catalog and the College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences requirements.

UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum: UNT complies with the mandate of the Texas Legislature regarding Core requirements for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

Choice of Catalog: Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.

The College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences required curriculum and policies are located in the <u>undergraduate catalog</u> under the corresponding catalog year.
