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The College of Visual Arts and Design requires that all major courses taken must be completed with a grade of 'C' or higher.

Students wishing to major in the Communication Design program in the College of Visual Arts and Design (CVAD) will be initially classified as a Pre-Communication Design major. To progress with the Communication Design program, students must complete ADES 1500 (available only at UNT in the Fall semesters) at least 2 courses from ART 1311, 1312, 1316, and 1317, and pass Candidacy Portfolio review. Once passed, there will be a subsequent Entry Review in the following Spring term which students must also pass before being admitted into the full major. Due to the highly sequenced curriculum, ADES courses cannot be taken concurrently unless otherwise listed as such. This means that regardless of the required total remaining credit hours, students should anticipate 4 years (8 Fall/Spring semesters) to complete to the BFA in Communication Design. For this reason, community college students should consult with a College of Visual Arts and Design (CVAD) advisor at the beginning of their academic career to establish expectations for the time to degree completion after transferring to UNT.

Courses Recommended for Transfer

Communication Design: Additional Requirements

No TCCNS options available for UNT's Design (ADES) courses.

In addition, students must also have the following:

- 24 advanced hours must be completed at UNT
- 36 hours of art (including at least 12 advanced hours) must be completed at UNT
- Transfer course work substituted for required UNT art courses must be approved by a student's faculty advisor during the degree audit process
- A 2.5 grade point average must be maintained in all art courses; only a grade of 'C' (2.0) or higher in art courses will count toward degree requirements; this also applies to any transfer coursework used towards the major



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Communication Design: Pre-Major

To be admitted to the communication design major (and to be eligible to enroll in subsequent major-specific course work), a pre-major must meet all the following requirements:

Have completed the following courses with a grade of 'C' or higher:

- **ARTS** 1311
- **ARTS** 1312
- **ARTS** 1316
- **ARTS** 1317
- **ADES** 1500 (at UNT only)

Additional requirement for the User-Experience Design concentration:

- **ADES** 1543 (at UNT only)

GPA Requirements:

- Have a minimum 2.75 GPA on required art courses
- Have a minimum 2.25 UNT GPA

Portfolio Reviews:

- Communication Design Candidacy Portfolio Review: Successful completion of Candidacy Portfolio Review is required for **ADES** 1543. This occurs at the end of the Fall semester of a student's first year at UNT.
- Communication Design Entry Portfolio Review: Successful completion of Entry Portfolio Review is required for admission to major and subsequent courses in the degree. This occurs at the end of the Spring semester of a student's first year at UNT.

Special Notes

Hours Required and General/College Requirements: A minimum of 120 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Fine Arts degree as specified in the General University Requirements section of the UNT catalog and the College of Visual Arts and Design requirements.

Academic Requirements: Art majors and art minors must take courses in sequence and must maintain at least a 2.75 grade point average in all art courses. Only grades of 'C' or higher in art courses will count toward a student's degree requirements.

Portfolio Review: All design and studio art majors require an entry portfolio review, which students must pass to continue in the major. Students who do not pass one or another of the successive required reviews should consult with their academic advisor regarding further options. Students should contact the department associated their major for specific expectations and procedures for all portfolio reviews.

UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum: UNT complies with the mandate of the Texas Legislature regarding [Core requirements](#) for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

Choice of Catalog: Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.
